- No budget line, allocation, disbursement or expenditure for FP programs. They are fully donor funded.
- After increasing steadily from FY 2016/17 to FY 2018/19, the FP commodities allocation as a share of the funding need decreased by four percentage points to 29.8%.
- The expenditure rate of the FP commodities allocation dropped from 80% in FY 2016/17 to 11% in FY 2018/19. There was no publicly available expenditure data for FY 2019/20, making it impossible to determine the rate for that year.
- · Government expenditure as a share of the FP commodities funding need decreased steadily from 16.5% in FY 2016/17 to 3.6% in FY 2018/19. There was no publicly available expenditure data for FY 2019/20, making it impossible to determine the share for that year.

*FP programs include: education and information services on FP and reproductive health; counseling on contraceptives and FP; and training health workers to provide FP information, education and communication.
