Summary


PAI's Government Accountability for Family Planning Budgets project supports 10 civil society advocates in seven African countries to hold their governments accountable for increasing domestic investments in FP and improving the transparency of FP budget data.

PAI is a civil society organization that works to advance universal access to sexual and reproductive health and rights through advocacy, partnerships and funding of changemakers.

The Common Framework

Developed by PAI and civil society advocates, the Common Framework for Measuring Government Spending on Family Planning is a set of standard indicators that follow the budget cycle from funding need to allocation, disbursement, expenditure and outcome and are used to measure the performances of governments investing in FP services and contraceptives, categorized as FP programs and FP commodities.*

Under-expenditure of FP allocations undermines the impact of government investment

- In FY 2020, Benin allocated 41% of the FP programs funding need, the highest among the three countries, and then spent only 26% of the allocation, meaning expenditure was only 11% of the funding need. To put it in context, only FCFA 69 was spent per woman of reproductive age (WRA), when FCFA 658 per WRA was needed.
- Burkina Faso's contraceptives allocation was 37% of the funding need in FY 2020, the highest among the three countries. However, only 69% of the allocation was spent. As a result, expenditure was only 25% of the funding need, meaning only FCFA 173 was spent per WRA, when FCFA 685 per WRA was needed.
