Kalb - theory is longer term contracts signed already in progress - CCA customers take up slack. Mendall - 6TW HR .005 centcap 30mm if no cap 60mm Would it cause EBCE to re-evaluate rate structure

Sutter- f under collect pge can raise rate? - PCIA Rates Choice to put 150mm to keep Diablo Canyon, why is it affecting PCIA? - Bndled with asset in 2018 decision

16. Carbon Free Allocation (Informational Item) Receive an update regarding potential carbon free energy allocation and associated timeline

Mendall - Allocation is being considered from PGE no renewables, why are those not included? Martinez - When will CPUC take action on the allocations. Pilch - issue before board is if it provides a market for the nuclear. Are we encouraging a market? Hernandez (SL) - is nuclear in unspecified mix that is part of our current products. Savings \$60mm can that be reinvested into cleaner energy.

Arreguin - Is the \$11mm already budgeted into allocations

Munro - Would like to see nuclear - not clean neither is natural gas, what are consequences of "dirty" energy and who is hurt by this. What are the costs of difference scenarios?

Mendall - hydro portion is acceptable. EBCE power mix is 15% natural gas - accept nuclear to clear out natural gas. Frame and look at it on our current mix. Choice is between

Bacon - Would disagree with natural gas / nuclear comparison, needs to be clean without including nuclear. Agrees with speakers, that this would be a disservice to the community.

CAC - Sutter - How were calculations made, how would the renewables mix be higher than PGE if we accept the allocation. Commercial customers -

Arreguin - thanked orgs for submitting comments. Would go contrary to the initiative approved by city, city calling for the closure of diablo valley Accept hydro allocation - refuse nuclear

Martinez - 1. Staff to address allegations of extending DC life Accepting carbon free, vs, enery, vs both elaborate on impact of taking attributes from PGE

Munro - what I the definition of cleaner and greater? Concern that nuclear is presented benign.

Hernandez (Dublin) - needs more informaton before moving forward.

Hernandez (sl) - needs additional information and would like to work with the community for representation.

Kalb - Glad Diablo being decomissioned. What will it look like to custoers and potential optouts if allocation is accepted.

Would have to buy large hydro or less of other sources.

David - Spoke against accepting allocation

Rebecca A - Spoke against nuclear allocation

Dave Degasman - Against nuclear power included in EBCE mix

Jessica Tovar - EBCPA opposes the inclusion of nuclear energy in mix, Public relations to community, agency reputation if allocation is accepted. Justification on Diablo Canyon staying open and PCIA.

Beth Weinberger - against nuclear, did not hear attempt associated with the risks of nuclear energy/waste and issues with nuclear plants. Risk of losing customers

Beth Kelly - Spoke against Nuclear power included in the EBCE mix. Steering committee rejected certain recs because of the energy mix.

Tom Kelly - electricity generated from nuclear power? Allocation of power from Diablo Canyon - taking an attribute with power. Sounds like Renewable energy credit (Rec) opposes Power from PGE doing so can delay creation of more renewable power. Move EBCE to 100% clean

David McCord - Welcomes carbon free energy, but only accept only the hydro power from PGE

Barbara Stebbins - Spoke against accepting nuclear allocation. Requested info on allocation mix was decided. Currently a motion from A4NR closed prior to 2025, costing customers over \$1b in above market costs for energy.

Chris Gilbert - Speaking as a customer. Against allocation and reminded board of Community aspect of program. Will cut off customers.

Benjamin Z. - Important to know I plan helps PGE or Diablo Canyon bottom line and does not support nuclear allocation

Melissa Yu - Spoke against nuclear energy and read Sierra Club letter. EBCE cannot compromise values, break customer trust
