Accept the CEO's report on contracts that EBCE has entered, as required by the Administrative Procurement Policy. **Items executed between June 9, 2021 to July 14, 2021;**

C-2021-047 Granicus (Denver, CO) Second Amendment to Service Agreement increases the not to exceed amount by \$50,487.49 for the term of July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022.

C-2021-048 SMUD (Sacramento) Amendment 2 to Task Order 2 Exhibit A: Scope of Services, expands services to cover NEM Policy changes, and adds \$63,000 to the total not to exceed.

C-2021-049 Wilson, Sonsini Goodrich & Rosati (Palo Alto) First Amendment to CSA adds \$300,000 to the total compensation and extends the termination date through June 30, 2022 (\$250,000 for each fiscal year).

C-2021-050 Richards, Watson & Gershon (San Francisco) First Amendment to CSA adds \$400,000 to the total compensation and extends the termination date through June 30, 2022 (\$350,000 for each fiscal year).

C-2021-051 Alameda County Transportation Commission Project Funding Agreement, provides \$120,000 to EBCE for Electric Vehicle Charging in Piedmont.
