Our website is a crucial link between EBCE and our customers and stakeholders. Having a site that brings our refreshed brand to life both visually and functionally is important to us. We count on our selected partner to help envision the optimal role for our website based on the goals articulated in the RFP and our brand strategy.
The description for the Approach section of the RFP on pg 10 writes "Not to exceed four (6) pages." Can you confirm the maximum pages for this section?	Apologies for the confusion. Please include up to six (6) pages for this section.
Is there a ballpark budget for this contract we should be aware of as we begin to prepare our response?	We have not specified a target budget for this effort.
Can you please verify the page limit in the key personnel section. Is it one page for the entire project team and their details EBCE has requested to see or one page per person on the project team?	We'd like to keep this summary information to one (1) page in total. Full bios are not required.
Section 6, Qualifications, states that a minimum of 5 years in business is a requirement for respondents to the RFP. Our company was incorporated in February 2022, but the two principals have been doing business together for >5 years. Is this disqualifying?	The intention of this requirement is to screen for bidders who have developed expertise in the field and can demonstrate a track record of sound strategic and business judgement. Please use the qualifications and key personnel sections of your response to convey the breadth and depth of expertise you would bring to this engagement.
We are not California-based. Is location a factor in your selection criteria?	Being based in California is not a requirement. However per our evaluation criteria found on page 8 of the RFP, those bidders in EBCE's service territory receive a small consideration under our Special Procurement Preferences policy.

For the most part, the people making decisions about the creative work will also be in key meetings. We will work closely with the selected partner to build a workplan that takes the board cadence into account.
