East Bay Community Energy (EBCE) is a Community Choice Aggregator that provides electric generation service and energy programs to residents and businesses in Alameda County (except the City of Alameda) and the City of Tracy. EBCE will expand to the City of Stockton in 2024.

EBCE is governed by a Board of Directors comprised of an elected official from each jurisdiction served. Board meetings are held monthly and are open to the public.

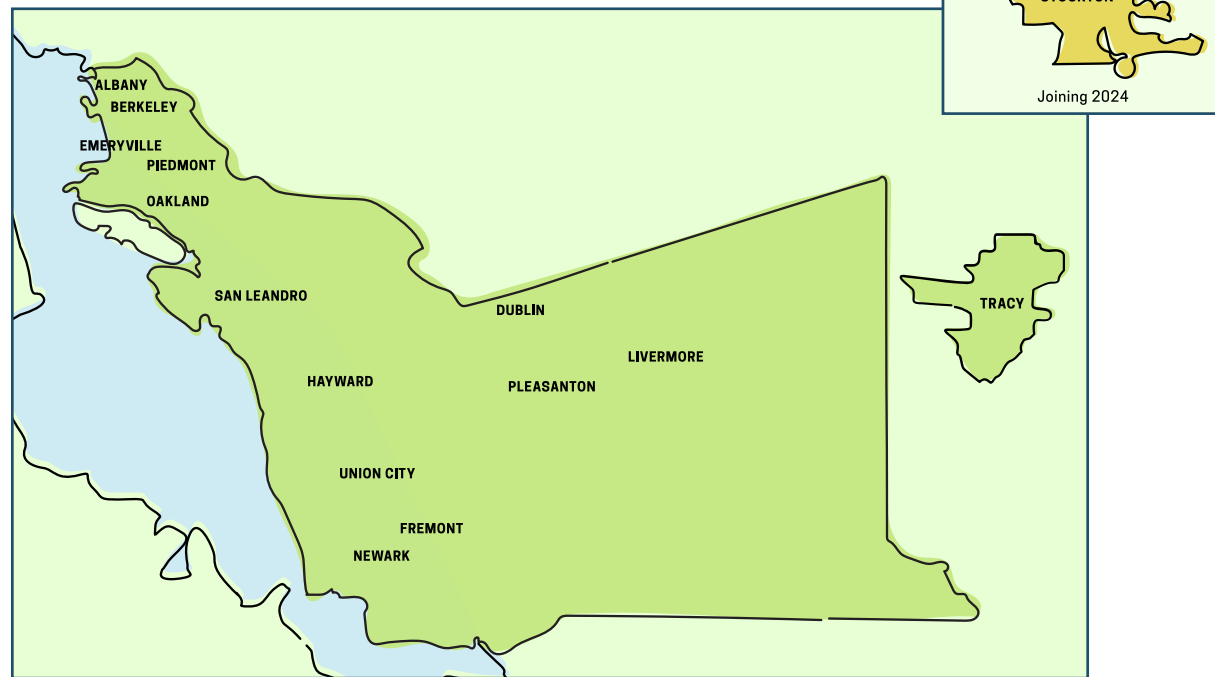

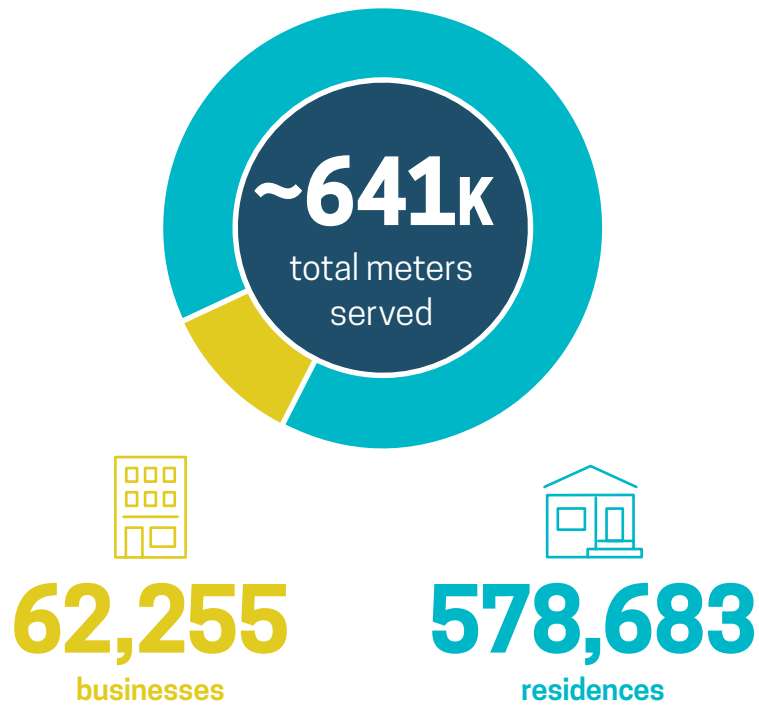
EBCE SERVICE AREA

EBCE is the default provider of electric generation service for all electricity accounts throughout Alameda County (except in the City of Alameda) and also the City of Tracy.



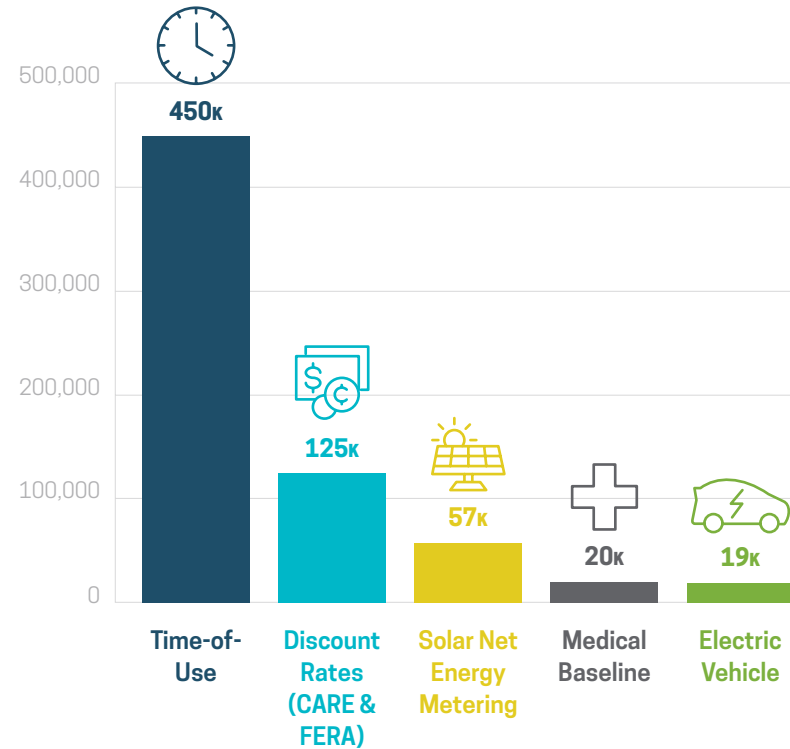

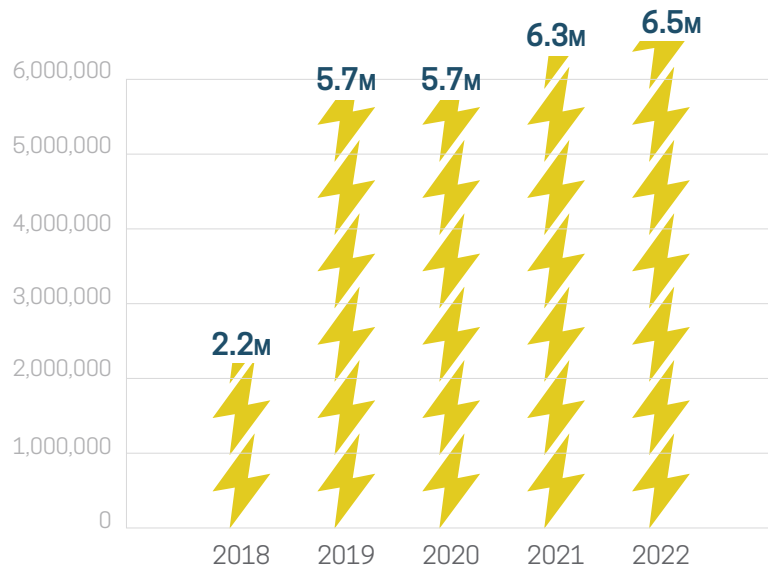

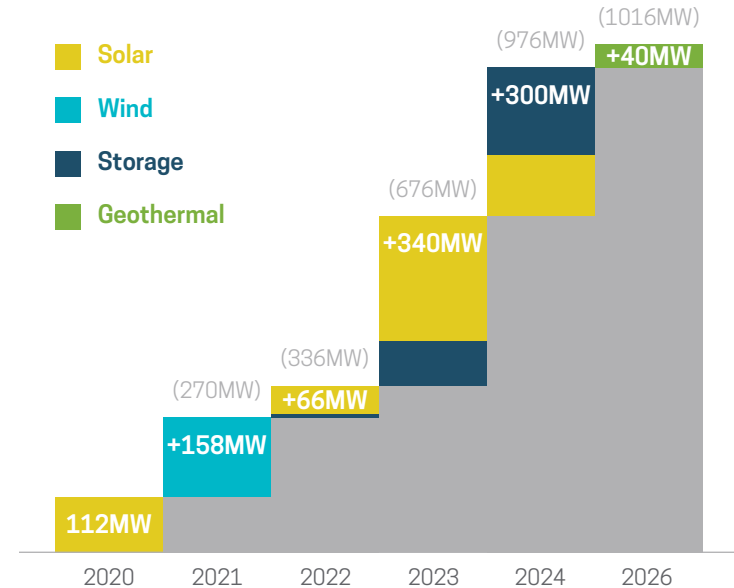
MEGAWATT-HOURS OF ELECTRICITY SOLD BY EBCE

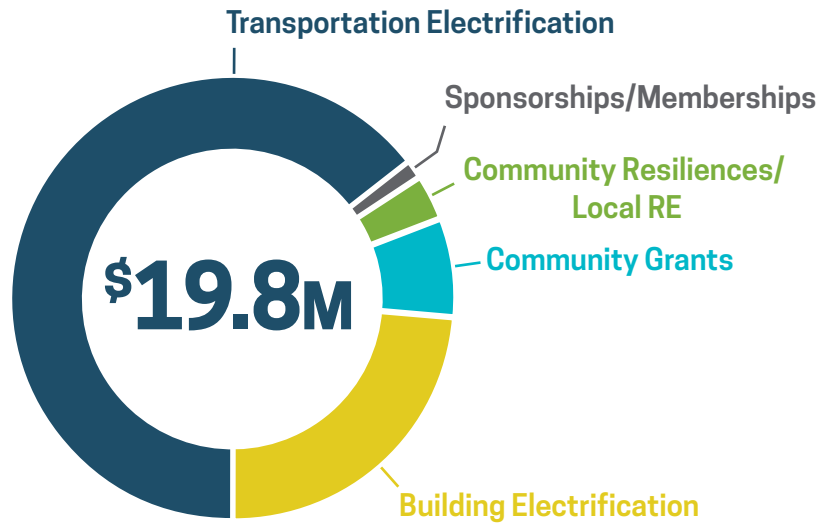
