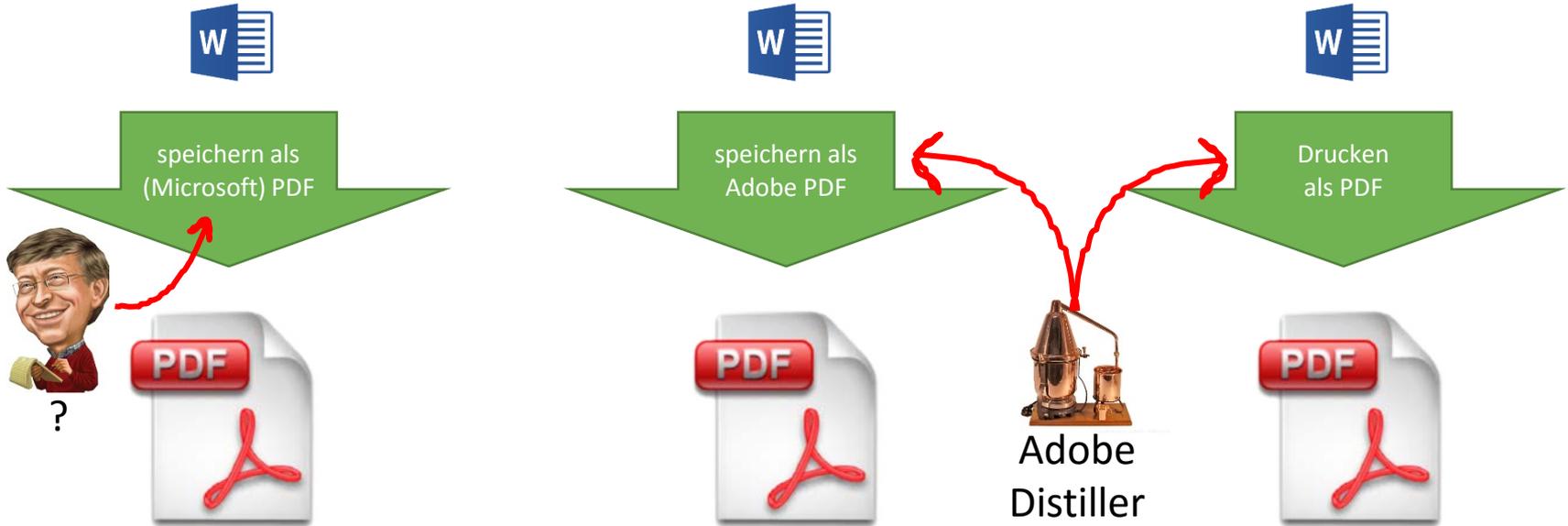

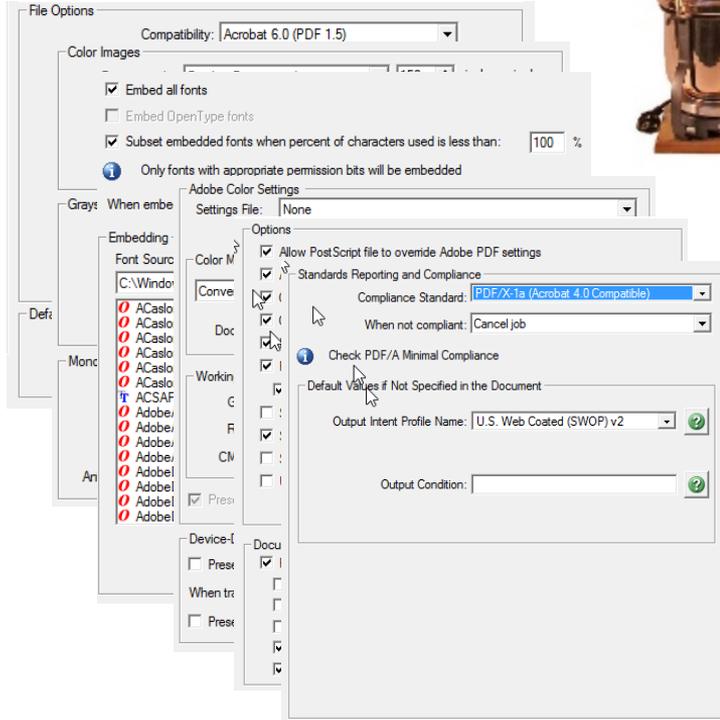

PDF Standards

- **PDF 1.7 (ISO 32000)** das eigentliche PDF-Format
- **PDF/A (ISO 19005)** Archivierung elektronischer Dokumente im PDF-Format
- **PDF/UA** Für Menschen mit Einschränkungen (Universal Accessibility)
- **PDF/X (ISO 15930)** Übermittlung von Druckvorlagen
- **PDF/E (ISO 24517)** Technische Dokumente (Engineering)
- **PDF/H (zukünftig)** Für das Gesundheitswesen (Healthcare)

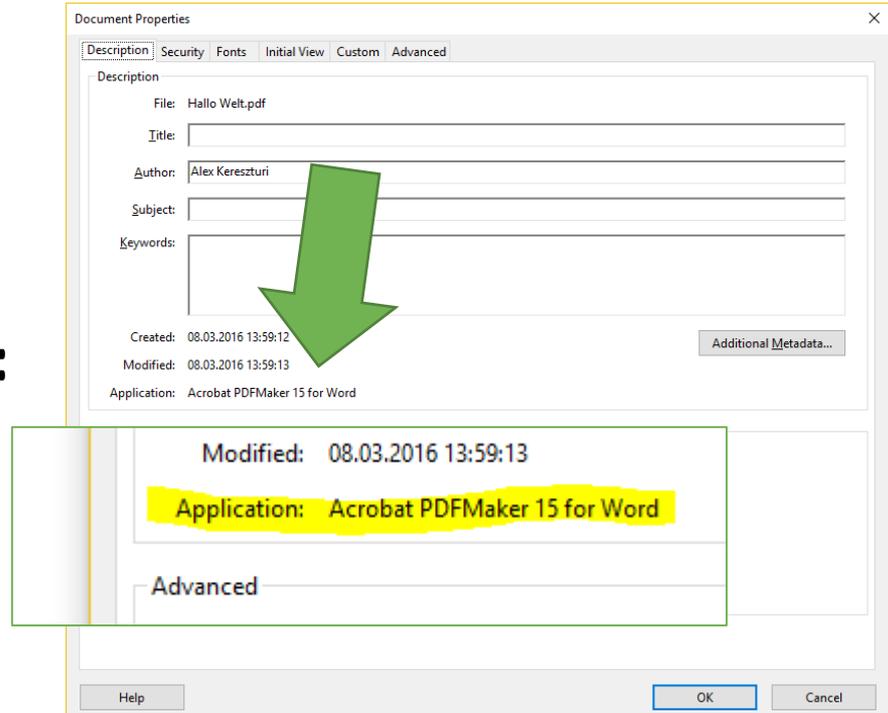

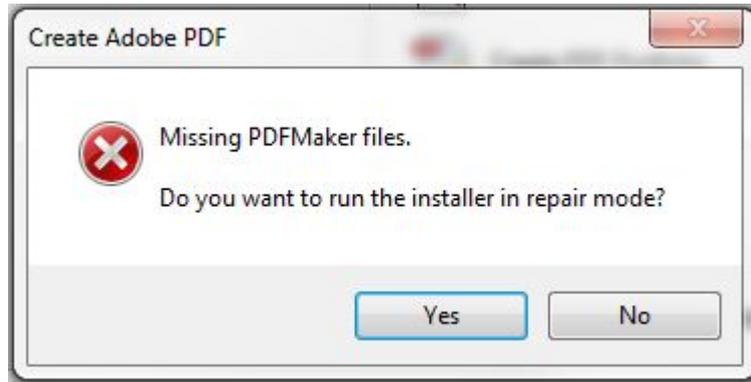

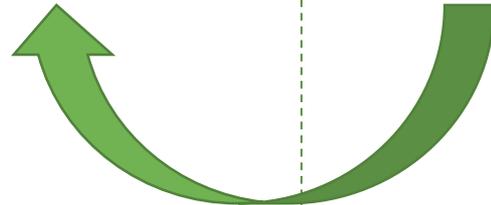
