Anglers Paradise – Eldorado and Nirvana Complex Rules – PLEASE read all rules. You can find specific rules for different lakes below.

- YOU MUST ENTER YOUR CAR REGISTRATION UPON BOOKING. THIS IS MANDATORY.
 YOUR BOOKING COULD BE CANCELLED IF THIS IS NOT ENTERED.
- WE REQUIRE ALL DETAILS OF ALL ANGLERS. PLEASE ENSURE YOU COMPLETE ALL FIELDS CORRECTLY AND IN DETAIL.
- NO Night Fishing allowed on Top Lake or Koi Lake.
- Maximum 2 rods.
- Barbless hooks only
- Leadcore is banned.
- Plastic baits are banned
- No spring loaded gadgets designed to aid the hooking of fish
- No Bait Boats or Drones
- Minimum Size 8 hooks on Carp Lakes, Minimum size 14 on others
- NO SACKING OF FISH OVER NIGHT, NO KEEP NETS. Unhooking Mats are MANDATORY
 on All Lakes and must be suitable in size for the resident fish.
- Large knotless nylon Landing Nets for all Lakes. Minimum of 30" on General Lake, 42"+
 on Carp and Cat Lakes. 50" or specialised nets are recommended when targeting
 Catfish.
- No pole fishing on the Carp and Cat Lakes.
- Minimum 10lb line throughout on Carp Lakes and 4lb on others. 15lb is advised on Cat and Carp 2 (Bottom Lake).
- Catfish rigs must be made with coated braids. We recommend 35lb+ soft coated.
- Fishing is from 8am to dusk or 9pm whichever is earlier (unless night fishing). Anglers arriving before 8am will receive an instant ban. Please respect the night anglers already present on the lake.
- No booking = no fishing. Anyone found fishing without a booking will receive an instant ban
- Forceps and disgorgers must be used.
- No braided main line except for spod and marker.
- Do not leave rods unattended.
- Anyone found LITTERING will be banned. Please take your rubbish home with you and ONLY leave your footprints.
- Bivvies only, NO TENTS ALLOWED.
- No Driving to the lakes. Anyone found driving to the lakes will receive an instant ban.
- At Spawning times or when oxygen levels are low, certain lakes may be temporarily closed. We reserve the right to close any lakes at any time.
- No Fly Fishing except on the Trout Lake

- No Standing Up with Fish Always Kneel down over a mat when handling Fish
- All children under the Age of 16 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT at all times whilst fishing.
- If you are NIGHT fishing You MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES if you are Under the Age of 18
- No live or dead baits. No raw meats. No raw liver etc.
- OUR BAILIFFS MAKE REGULAR SPOT CHECKS
- THE ABOVE RULES ARE STRICTLY ENFORCED, FAILURE TO OBSERVE THE RULES COULD RESULT IN A BAN FROM FISHING

Nirvana Fishery rules

- FISH CARE IS ALWAYS PRIORITY
- Catch and release only. Removal of fish will result in prosecution
- Barbless hooks
- Minimum size 8 hook
- No artificial/plastic baits
- No leadcore
- No braid except spod & marker
- No shock leaders
- No dogs or pets
- No bait boats, fish finders or drones
- No nuts
- Under 18s must be accompanied by an 'angler' aged 18+
- No poles
- No quiver tip/feeder/float rods. Carp/Cat rods only
- No lure fishing
- Two rods per angler unless option for a third rod has been chosen at time of purchasing ticket.
- No tents. Bivvy and brolly systems only
- No spring-loaded gadgets designed to aid hooking of fish
- The 360 rig is banned
- Long shank curve hooks are banned
- Rods should be detached from fish prior to moving fish to the unhooking mat. Attempt to unhook the fish in the water. Detach or cut the rig if this is not possible.
- In case of a snap off all leads must be able to disconnect from the rig
- Never pull for a break. Report snagged fish. Do not leave tackle on islands or in trees. Please report ANY incidents of breakages, caused by fish or otherwise
- No fishing close to the monk/drain
- No loud music. Always keep noise to a minimum. Please use a receiver. Always Respect fellow anglers.
- Do not leave rods unattended
- No excessive alcohol consumption. We understand fishing is a way to relax and unwind, and some enjoy this to be accompanied by an alcoholic drink. We kindly ask this to be discreetly enjoyed in a responsible and respectful manner.
- We understand most anglers are self-sufficient and toilet responsibly with their own

means and within their area. But please consider the only toilets available are those located near reception, at the back of the bar. If these facilities are not used, please bring your own. Keep the countryside clean!!

- Tickets are none transferable and nonrefundable
- Only ticket holders are permitted to walk around the lake they hold a ticket for. Respect the privacy of other anglers.
- No guests
- No visitors
- Maximum 2 people per lake. Exceptions can be made for Anglers Paradise holiday guests. In this case anglers will be limited to two rods each.
- Always have a separate bucket for fresh lake water to pour over your mat and fish
- Specialist antiseptic must be used
- Fish are to be retained for length of time it takes to set up photography equipment only
- Fish must be released using a retainer/weigh sling. Not by hand.
- Do not release fish in to weed. Look for a clear area
- Never stand up holding a fish
- Please spend time with the fish on release
- Tickets strictly start at midday and end at 11am
- No arriving before 11.30am
- Anglers must be packed up and off the lake by 11am
- No driving on Winsford Lane between 9pm and 7am
- Always close the gate!
- No driving to the lakes
- Barrows are advised
- No touching the fence. Beware of the electric strand.
- Take rubbish home with you. Leave only footprints
- All photos of captures must be shared with the fishery via the Catch App Catch Reports and/or email; info@anglers-paradise.co.uk
- A bailiff makes regular checks. Anglers will be asked to reel rods in for rig checks. Anglers will be expected to have all fish care equipment on show.
- Nirvana is private. Please report any non-ticket holders walking round the lakes to the office
- Rule breakers will be asked to leave. No exceptions. The bailiff's word is final

Anglers Paradise holiday guest booking policy for Nirvana Lakes; Speci Cat, Xanadu and Fatboys.

- It is possible for Anglers Paradise holiday guests to receive a minimum 50% discount. Discounts can only be redeemed by booking during time of holiday and when on site and is dependent on availability. Please enquire at the reception or tackle shop.
- Two rods per angler only
- Day tickets can be arranged. In this instance fishing start time will be no earlier than 9am. End time will be dusk or 8pm, whichever is earlier.
- We reserve the right to book other Anglers Paradise guests on to the lake. In this instance
- Groups of up to six Anglers Paradise guests may exclusively book Fat Boys depending

on availability. But must not fish the bank below Xanadu.

- Costs to Anglers Paradise guests depending on availability: £10-day, £20 midday to 11am
- If Anglers Paradise guests wish to have the lake exclusively for one or two anglers, they must pay the full price and book through Catch. This can be done in advance to avoid disappointment.

Nirvana Specimen Catfish Lake Rules:

- Minimum 50 inch landing nets or Catfish nets required
- Extra-large, padded unhooking mats or specialist mats are a must.
- Specialist weigh slings and equipment is needed
- Minimum 20lb line
- Minimum of 4lb test curve rods or specialist Catfish rods
- No mainline braid
- Hook links must 35lb+ and coated
- Do not pose for pictures with the Catfish lifted off the ground. For photos, please present the tail up your arm or lay next to the fish.
- Catfish should be manoeuvred in weigh slings only.
- No raw meats or fish
- No live or dead baits
- No lure fishing
- You may fish from other parts of the lake opposed to the purpose-built swims.
- 2/3 rods per swim only. 3 rods can be used if option chosen at time of purchasing ticket.
- Please also study the fishery rules

Nirvana Xanadu Lake Rules:

- 2/3 rods per swim only. 3 rods can be used if option chosen at time of purchasing ticket
- Minimum 15lb line
- Fish from designated swims only
- Please also study the fishery rules

Nirvana Fatboys Lake Rules:

- 2/3 rods per swim only. 3 rods can be used if option chosen at time of purchasing ticket
- Minimum 12lb line

- Fish from designated swims only
- Please also study the fishery rules

Nirvana Trout Lake Rules:

Trout Lake Rules

- Fly fishing only
- No bait, pellet etc
- Strictly catch and release
- Barbless single hooks
- Minimum 5lb leader
- Rubber mesh landing nets must be used
- Unhooking mats must be used
- Try and unhook fish in the water
- Minimum handling of fish possible
- Release fish in the net, holding upright. Allow it to kick several times before releasing
- No guests
- No visitors
- No arriving before 8am
- No leaving after dusk or 8pm, whichever is earlier
- No driving on Winsford Lane between 9pm and 7am
- Always close the gate!
- Anglers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult
- Tickets are none transferable and none refundable
- Take rubbish home with you. Leave only footprints
- Nirvana is private. Please report any non-ticket holders walking round the lakes to the office
- All photos of captures must be shared with the fishery via the Catch App Catch Reports and/or
- A bailiff makes regular checks.
- Rule breakers will be asked to leave. No exceptions. The bailiff's word is final.
- This lake will be closed from June to and including September. This is due to high water temperatures. It will also close before, during
