Thank you for buying a DCAC Day Ticket. You are our guest, and we hope you enjoy your fishing. Please read and observe these simple rules. As long as you do, we'll be happy to see you again.

You MUST:

- take responsibility for your own safety and actions
- be more than 18 years old
- behave responsibly
- be courteous to fellow anglers, farmers, and land-owners
- use barbless hooks and a wetted unhooking mat if you catch a decent fish
- park in the designated places only
- hold a current rod licence

You MUST NOT:

- night fish you may set up 30 minutes before sunrise (times in national press/web), stop fishing at sunset, and be off the water within the next 30 minutes
- be drunk or take illegal drugs
- light fires, cut down vegetation, or bring dogs except for a recognised assistance dog
- bring children under 18
- use more than two rods
- · remove or kill any fish of any species
- leave any litter
