

## Writing Guidelines

Authors must carefully review the following requirements before submitting a manuscript to the Bangladesh Journal of International Law (BJIL).

### Structure of the Manuscript

A research article should ordinarily contain:

1. Title
2. An abstract that can be up to 300 words
3. A table of contents
4. A structured body of the text, including the introduction and conclusion

## Submission Requirements

### File format

The files shall be sent either as an MS Word file or as a Google Docs file. The files shall not be sent in PDF format.

### Language

The articles shall be written in English.

### Length

The length of the articles shall be more than 3000 words.

### Style

The articles shall follow the latest edition of the Oxford University Standard for the Citation of Legal Authorities (OSCOLA).

**No plagiarism of any kind will be tolerated!**

Each submission must include:

1. An anonymised manuscript in Microsoft Word format;
2. A separate author-information document;
3. A declaration of originality and competing interests; and
4. Any additional material required by the relevant call for papers.
