PATTERN CORRECTION - THE KNITTING BOOK

LACE SHAWL

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PATTERN

Using a knit-on cast-on (see p.88) and 6mm (UK4/US10) needles, cast on 190sts. Change to 4.5mm (UK7/US7) needles and cont as follows:

WORK EDGING

Row 1 (WS): K.

Row 2: [Knit but wrap yarn twice around needle, bringing both loops through] to end.

Row 3: [Purl into one of two loops in next stitch,

knock off other loop] to end.

Change to 3.75mm (UK9/US5) needles.

Row 4: [K2tog] to end. (95sts)

(...pattern continues...)

WORK TOP EDGING

Row 1 (RS): [(K1, p1) into next stitch] to end. (190sts)

Change to 4.5mm (UK7/US7) needles and work as follows:

Row 2: [Purl but wrap yarn twice around needle, bringing both loops through] to end.

Row 3: [Knit into one of two loops in next stitch, knock off other loop] to end.

Cast off using a 6mm (UK4/US10) needle.

Handwash and wet block (see p.277), making sure to stretch lace pattern out until visible and keep edges of scarf straight.
