
What will the Street of the Future look like?

DK is updating our classic book, A Street Through Time. As part of this we want to know what children now think the future will look like. We would love you to submit your class's ideas for our editors and illustrators to use in the book.

Class activity:

Look at a street from the past such as a Victorian street (pictured below) with gas lighting and steam trains, to name just a few new inventions which changed lives.

Here are two options for how you can ask your class to approach this activity:



- 1. Give out the downloadable form and ask your class to draw or write about a street in 2070 individually. They could think about these questions to inspire their ideas:
 - **Transport** how will you travel in the future? What vehicles will you see in the street? How will you get to school?
 - Buildings How will buildings look? Will there be buildings? What will they be made of? Will there be shops on the street? What kind of buildings will there be?
 - Clothes what will you be wearing in 2070? Will we need to wear anything to help us in our everyday life?
 - Home what will your home be like? Will it be in one place or will it move? How many rooms will there be? And who will you live with? What kind of things will you have in your home?
- 2. Divide your class up into groups and allocate them each an area of life to consider, from the list above. Get them to present back to the class or group to see what everyone thinks. Get someone in the class to be the scribe and get everyone to agree. Put this on the downloadable form.
