



Let's join the rabbits on their nighttime stroll!

The moon looks like a big round circle. It's a full moon! Can you draw the full moon that they see?












After a night of no moon at all,

Encourage children and their guardians to come in their pajamas for a fun toddler time event in which you explore the phases of the moon!

Start with a circle time for introductions and read DK's Good Night, Baby Moon together. Kids can then branch off with their guardians to work on the activity kits.
