Perfect for babies ages 0-2, this activity will help develop motor skills and occupy the youngest learners with stimulating play inspired by DK's **Pop-Up Peekaboo!** series.

SILLY VEHICLE SOUNDS

From race cars to rocket ships, **Pop-Up Peekaboo! Things That Go** features all sorts of vehicles. As you make your way through the book, come up with a sound to use for each different vehicle. A car might say "vroom vroom" and a boat might go "toot toot." To add even more fun, come up with a simple movement, gesture, or pose inspired by each vehicle in the book. Perform each movement with baby as you read through the book together. Check out our examples below, or create your own!

SCOOP

A digger helps **SCOOP** up rubble at construction sites. Put your hands together to form a cup. Then experiment with **SCOOPING** up things around you. Try using small, light objects like grapes or cereal.





sway

Boats **SWAY** from side to side as the waves move them. Sitting cross-legged on the floor, move your upper body side to side like a boat bobbing in the waves.


tall

Rocket ships are **TALL** and pointed. Bring your hands together over your head to form the tip of the rocket ship. Stand up as **TALL** as you can. You're ready to shoot off into space!




