Sunflowers in a wood vase

flower



you will need

7 sunflowers

materials

Florist's scissors Green tack | bag of kindling wood | clean recycled glass jar, just shorter than the lengths of kindling Garden string, coloured string, or natural or coloured raffia





Fix 2 horizontal strips of green tack at equal distances around the jar. Stick the lengths of kindling onto the green tack in straight vertical lines, butting them up against each other.

Wind string around the wood and tie in a knot. Half-fill the jar with water. Add the sunflowers, trimming their stems so they sit just above the rim of wood. Top up with more water.

ᢜ insider tips

• Remove all the leaves and cut and split the stems before arranging the sunflowers in the vase.

• The kindling used here is store-bought and so of a standard length. If you use other kindling, trim it with secateurs or a small hand saw if it is too long.
