Snowflakes

Do you want to build a snowman? How about some smiley snowmen faces? These symmetrical snowflake designs are snowgies—the tiny, mischievous snowmen that appear when an unwell Elsa sneezes.

You will need:

- Tracing paper
- White paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Thin white thread
- Clear tape
 - Hole punch

Fold and cut

Each snowflake is made from just one sheet of plain white paper and a templated segment of a Snowgie. No sneezing required!

You could use a pair of compasses.

Draw a circle 4³/₄ in (12 cm) in diameter.




Fold the circle into quarters, and then half again, with firm, straight creases.



Trace the template on page 197 onto the top segment of your circle.

Keep the layers offolded paper tightly together while you're cutting.



Carefully cut out the pattern. Because the paper is folded, you will cut through all parts at once.



Unfold your snowflake, being careful not to tear it. If you would like to hang it, tape some fine thread onto the back.
