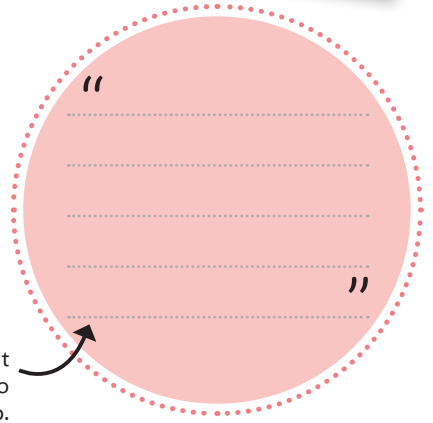

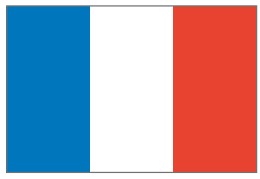

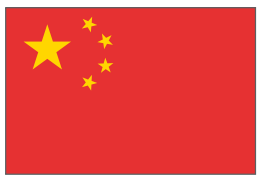

CELEBRATE! Host an International Day virtual event with the following activities:

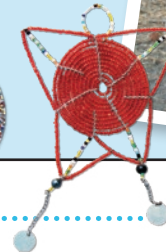
1 **Arrange a picture potluck.** Ask each child to show a photograph of an ethnic food that represents their culture. Jack's family enjoys Irish stew, and Shaowei's family enjoys chow mein.



2 **Encourage the group to dress in traditional garments.** Murk wears a traditional salwar kameez with a scarf covering her hair, and Bassma wears a dress called a kaftan for special events.



3 **Ask each child to share a cultural dance, song, story, or other tradition with the class.** Andre plays the didgeridoo, a traditional Aboriginal instrument, and Shigo is learning to make traditional Maasai bead jewelry.



4 **Prompt the children to fill out their own Children Just Like Me profile page** and share it with the class.

5 Have the children decorate their video backgrounds with **flags and other colorful decorations** to make it feel like a true celebration.



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
