HOW TO MAKE

FEED THE MONSTERS

You'll need a huge sheet of cardboard for this project, so you can fill it with lots of hungry monsters. Make sure you also have enough cardboard to make two identical stand pieces, so that your board stays upright when you feed the monsters.









On a large sheet of cardboard, draw lots of monster faces with wide open mouths and sharp teeth.



Cut along the diagonal line.

Then, use your first stand piece as a template to create another.



To make your paper balls, scrunch up coloured paper into tight balls and wrap them in sticky tape.



Carefully cut out holes where you have drawn the monsters' mouths. You might want to ask an adult to help.



Score along the horizontal lines on both stand pieces to make tabs. Fold the tabs upwards.



Decorate your board and leave the paint to dry. Then stand it upright and you're ready to play!




Make the stand for your board.

Take a square piece of cardboard and draw three lines on it as shown above.



Tape the tabs to each side of the board at the back. The diagonal edge of each stand piece should touch the floor.
