

Marbled tree baubles

Every Christmas the same question crops up: what colour scheme should we choose for the tree decorations? This year, you can create your own customized combination.

Bespoke baubles are absolutely perfect if you are looking for Christmas tree decorations which will stand out from the classic red, but are unusual while still being festive and fashionable. They are quick to make and, of course, you can choose whatever colours your heart desires.

How it's done:



1. Attach a piece of string to a Christmas tree bauble. Fill a large bowl with enough lukewarm water to completely submerge the bauble.



3. Now immerse the bauble completely in the bowl, holding the cap and ring to push it under water.



2. Add a few drops from each of the bottles of nail varnish to the water. The nail varnish will form a thin, colourful film on the surface of the water.



4. A thin layer of nail varnish will coat the bauble. Hang it up to dry for a couple of hours.

You will need:

- * colourful thread or string
- * scissors
- * white Christmas tree baubles in various sizes
- * large bowl
- * nail varnish in 2 colours, here: orange and lilac
