


A journey stick is a memento of your outdoor adventures. Make one by collecting things like flowers and leaves, and tying them to a stick. Then you can use your special stick to tell people the tales of your adventures.



My stick may be small, but I've been on BIG adventures.

> Space out your mementos along the stick.

Use string or sticky tape to attach your treasure to a stick.



You will need: natural ítems found on the ground • string or sticky tape long stick

You can add shells, feathers, stones, or whatever you want to your stick.

Use your journey stick to share the stories of your adventures, explaining the secrets behind each item you've kept. What does each object term The Indigenous Peoples of North America and Australia have used sticks in similar ways for many years.

The longer the stick, the more treasures you can tie to it!

Be mindful of what your child collects. Make sure they only choose things that are loose on the ground.
