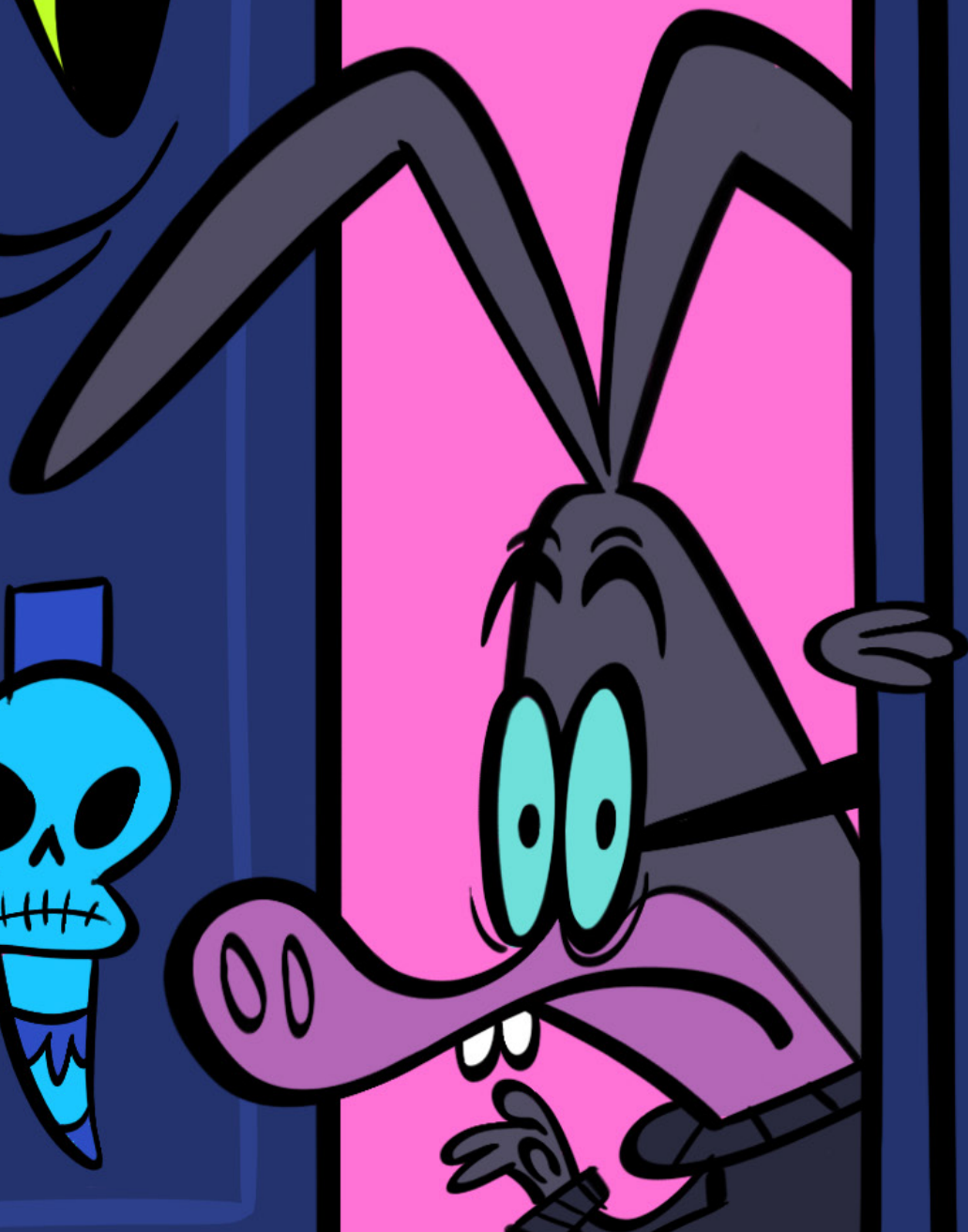

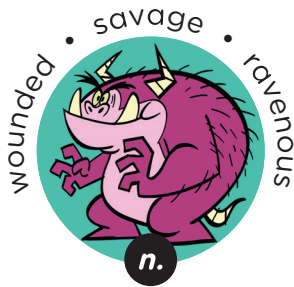

Monster words

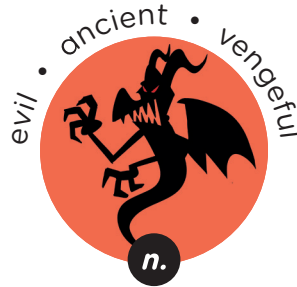
There are many types of monsters. Some are gigantic and fire-breathing, and others dwell in the deepest, darkest oceans. Pick your favorite kind.
