SHETLAND, SCOTLAND

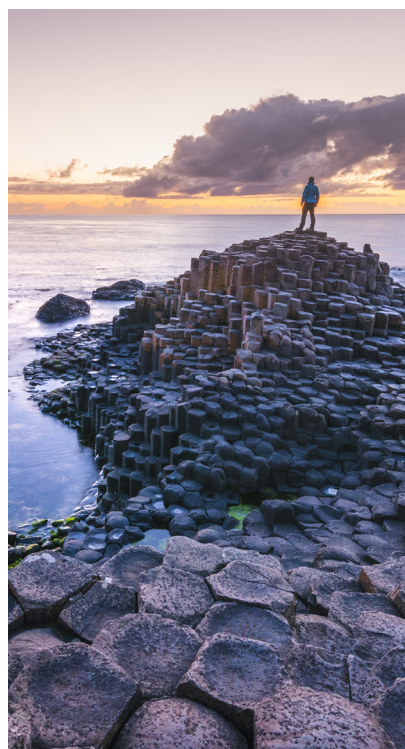

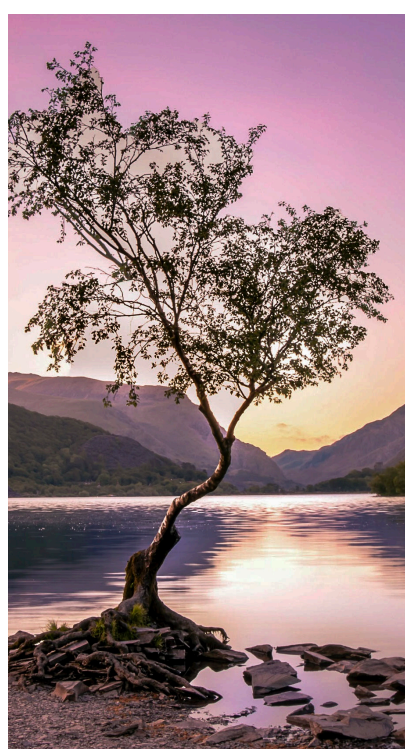

Studded with ancient stone cottages, Dingle's green hills are at their most lush when they've sloughed off the dregs of winter.

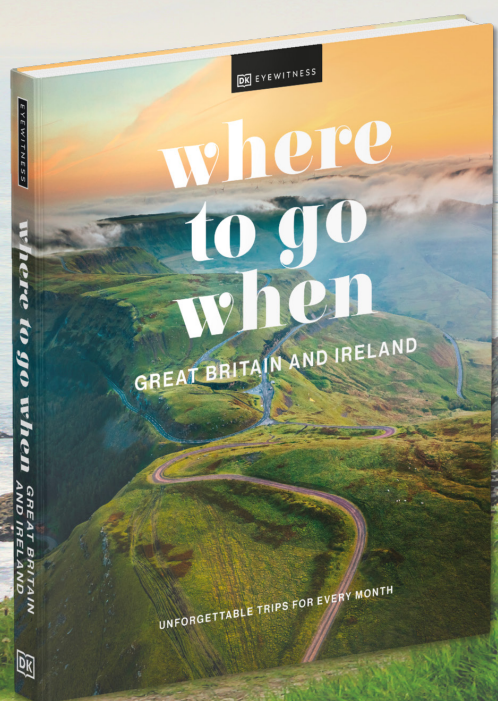

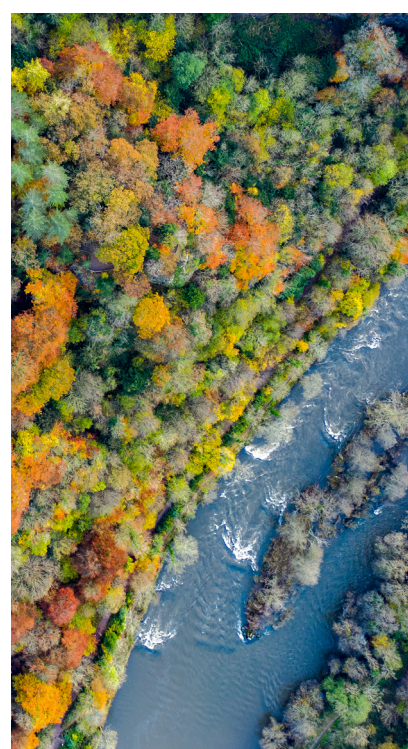
