How to piece together and use your pattern

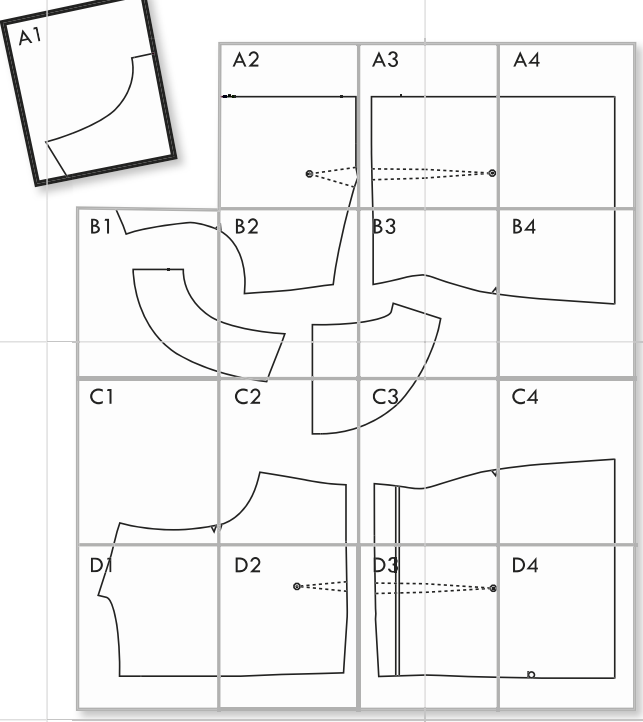

Download this PDF pattern to your computer, and print it out. The pages will be labelled in the order that they fit together.
- 2

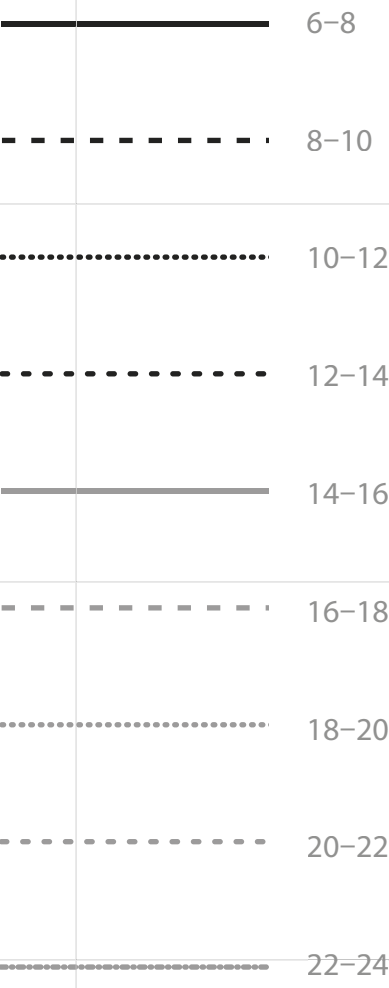
Trim the white margins from the printed pages, and tape the pages together, using the letters and gridlines as a guide (see example in the diagram below).
- 3

Refer to the body measurement charts on p.342 to select a size. Use the key on the pattern to find the line for your chosen size and cut around it.
- 4

A seam allowance of 1.5cm (5⁄16in) is included in the pattern pieces. After you have cut out the pattern pieces in your size, you may wish to add seamlines 1.5cm (5⁄16in) inside the cutting lines (see p.343). One square in the grid equals 5cm²; you will also find a 10cm² test square on the pattern to make sure that the pattern has printed at the correct size.
