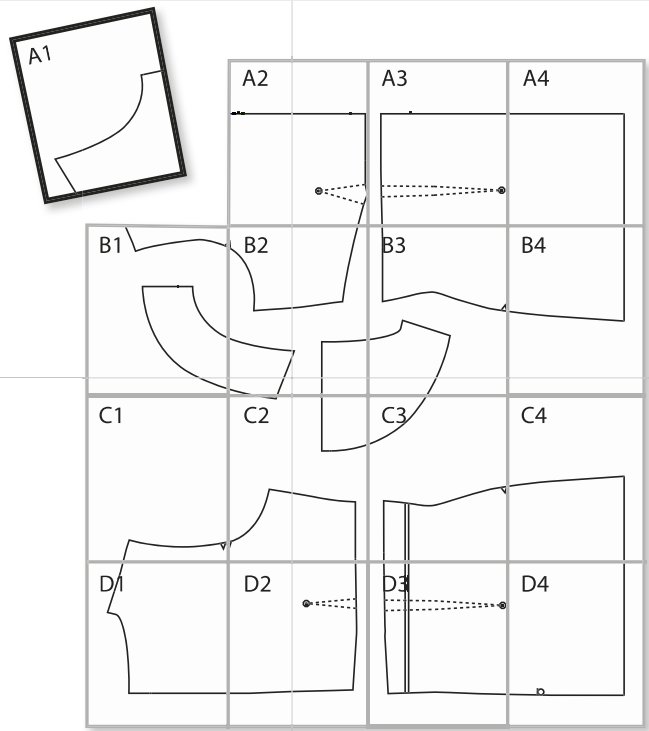


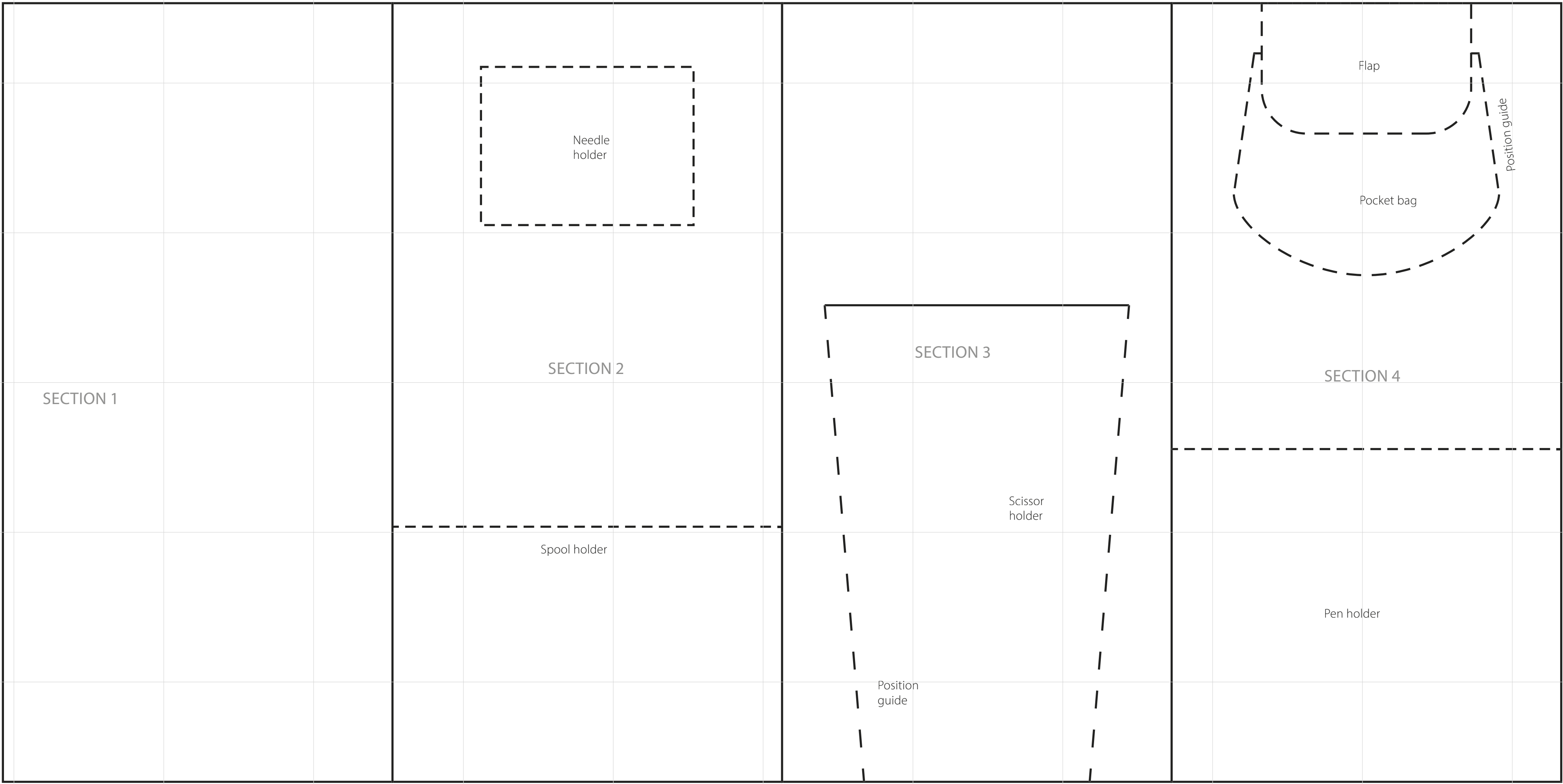
CRAFTER'S WRAP
POSITION GUIDE

How to piece together and use your position guide

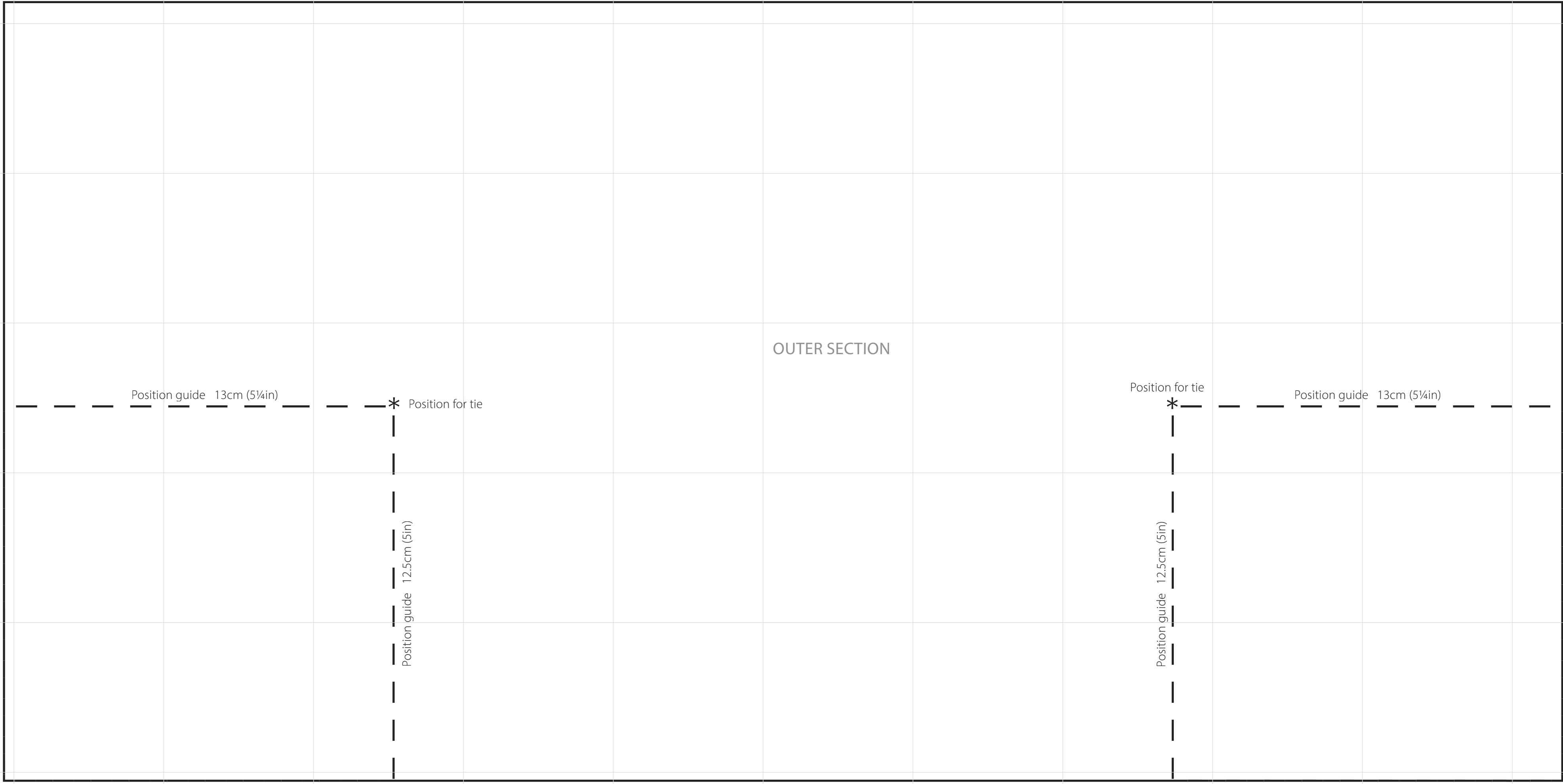
- 1
- Download this PDF position guide to your computer and print it out. The pages will be labelled in the order that they fit together.
- 2
- Trim the white margins from the printed pages, and tape the pages together, using the letters and gridlines as a guide (see example in the diagram below).
- 3
- Use the guide to help you position the pattern pieces on the inner and outer sections of the wrap.

How to piece together and use your pattern

- 1

Download this PDF pattern to your computer, and print it out. The pages will be labelled in the order that they fit together.
- 2

Trim the white margins from the printed pages, and tape the pages together, using the letters and gridlines as a guide (see example in the diagram below). Cut around the pattern.
- 3

The seam allowance is included in the pattern. One square in the grid equals 5cm; you will also find a 10cm² test square on the pattern to make sure that the pattern has printed at the correct size.
