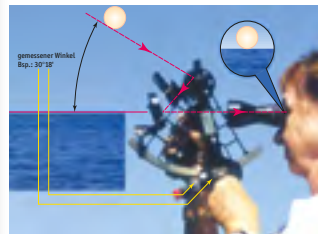

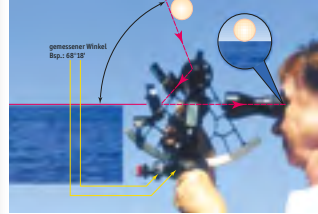

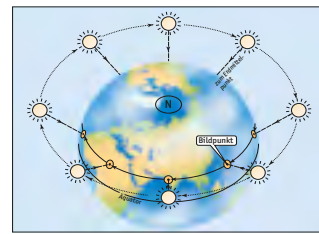


Sonnenstehung im Spiegelbild des Sextanten.

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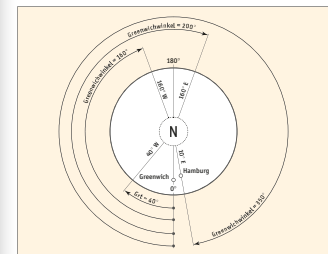

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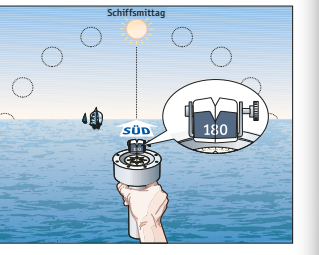
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VI. Die erste Standlinie – die Mittagsbreite

noch unbekannt waren, war die Mittagsbreite die Navigationsmethode auf hoher See schließlich, weil zur Berechnung der astronomischen Standlinie die Stellung der Sonne als Zeitangabe anreichte. Wenn es sich auch bei der Mittagsbreite um einen speziellen – höchst einfachen – Sonderfall der astronomischen Navigation handelte, so beruht sie dennoch auch auf der gleichen Überlegung, die wir zu Beginn gemacht haben (Seite 16 ff.). Die astronomische Standlinie ist ein Kreis um den Bildpunkt mit der Entfernung «Berechneter Bildpunkt als Radius.

Wie der Name sagt, kann die Sonne bei der Mittagsbreite nur in dem Zeitpunkt gemessen werden, in dem Schiffsmittag ist. Dies hat nun gar nichts mehr mit unserem bürgerlichen Mittag um 12 Uhr zu tun. Verfolgen wir die Sonne auf ihrem Weg über das Firmament während eines Tages-



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ablaades, so lässt sich beobachten, dass die Sonne morgens irgendwo im Osten aufgeht, dann vornehmlich aufsteigt, langsam Richtung Westen wandert, irgendwann auf dem höchsten Punkt ihrer Bahn steht, wieder sinkt und schließlich gegen Abend irgendwo im Westen hinter dem Horizont verschwindet. Natürlich wissen wir, dass sich in Wirklichkeit die Erde um die eigene Achse dreht, unsere Voreinstellungskraft entspricht es aber besser, wenn wir zum Zwecke des Erfassens der Astronavigation ruhig die Sonne um die Erde wandern lassen. Wir haben also gelernt, dass die Sonne mittags im Süden steht. Würden wir auf einem Schiff unabhängig von der Uhrzeit die Sonne mit dem Kompass in dem Moment anpeilen, in dem sie an ihrem höchsten Punkt steht, so würden wir eine rechtwinklige Polung von ganz genau 180°, also Süden, erhalten.* Dieser Zeitpunkt ist Schiffsmittag.

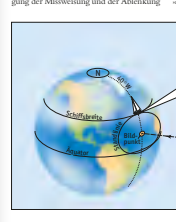

RAHMEN

Wenn man sich den Rahmen eines Gravelbikes anschaut, sieht es auf den ersten Blick aus wie ein Rennrad, aber der Winkel steckt im Detail. Die Geometrie des Gravel-Rads ist ausgelegt auf Komfort. Im Vergleich zum Cyclocrossbike ist der Radstand, also die Distanz zwischen den beiden Laufrädern, länger.

Das führt zu mehr Stabilität und mehr Komfort, da Vibrationen besser absorbiert werden. Zudem sitzt die Barbel im Vergleich tiefer, damit liegt der Schwerpunkt tiefer, und somit sitzt man stabiler auf dem Rad – das ist vor allem mit zusätzlichem Gepäck und Gewicht vorteilhaft. Das erweist sich auch für lange Stunden im Gegenwind als entscheidender Vorteil. Weiterhin ist die Gabel breiter als beim Rennrad, was nicht nur breitere Reifen erlaubt, sondern auch dafür sorgt, dass der Schlamm nicht zwischen Gabel und Reifen stecken bleibt. Durch den steileren Winkel des Sitzrohrs sitzt man auf dem Gravelbike weiter vorn als beispielsweise beim Rennrad.

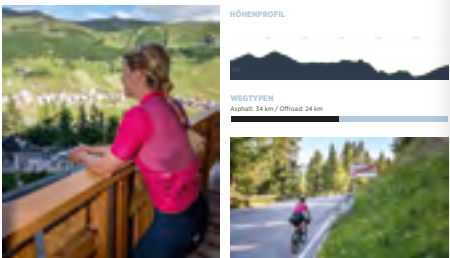

Bisher war ich dem Zelten nicht gewachsen, da ich immer noch die Erinnerungen an ungemütliche Nächte im Zeltlager mit luftdurchlässiger Matratze und stundenlangem Zeltbau im zarten Alter von neun Jahren verarbeitete. Mittlerweile habe ich mich aber überreden bzw. überzeugen lassen, das Zelt doch noch einmal auszuprobieren, da es anscheinend beratungsschlaffendlicher geworden ist. Weiter unten stelle ich deshalb auch eine Ausrüstung vor, die zum Bikepacking geeignet ist.

Für das eher schmale Budget lassen sich Zelt oder Tarp an, das sich mit der richtigen Technik einbauen in den Bikepacking-Taschen vorfinden lassen.

This is not least due to its most famous owner: James Dean's tragic accidental death was in a 550 Spyder - both are immortal till today. 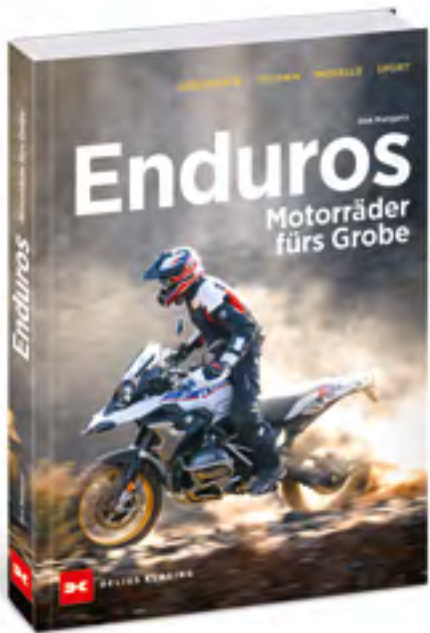

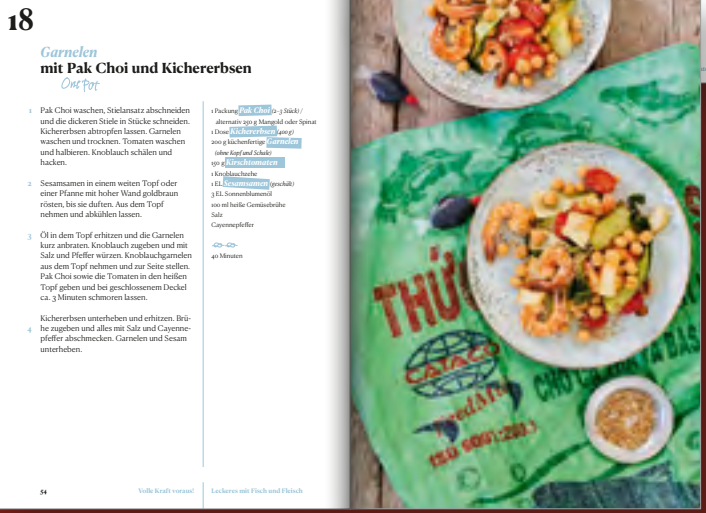

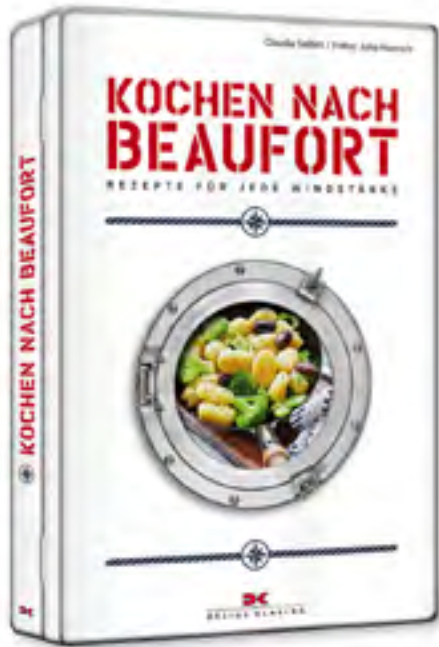
