Junior Trophy

Participation conditions

1. General

The participants of the Junior Trophy are eligible to participate only with a written consent of at least one legal guardian. In case of registering on-site, this must be documented with a signature of one legal guardian on the registration form. If the registration is made online, the consent of the legal guardian is given by accepting the declaration of liability..

2. Health

Parents are obliged to make sure that their children meet the fitness requirements of the Junior Trophy. If necessary, they have to consult a doctor in order to check for these requirements.

3. Material

All kinds of bikes are allowed to participate in the Junior Trophy.

The following equipment is strictly not allowed:

- · Bottle cages behind or under the saddle
- · Drinking bottles made from non-deformable materials such as glass, aluminum etc.

All participants are obliged to make sure their bicycles are operating properly, especially with regard to brakes and other parts relevant to safety. In case of technical shortcomings a participant may be disqualified from the start of the Junior Trophy.

The rules

1. STARTING AREA

The starting line of the Junior Trophy is directly on the festival site (at the marathon finishing line – "Vor den Weiden")

2. STARTING LINEUP

The starts take place in two time blocks. The start line will be set up 5 minutes before the start signal. The first lap is a warm-up for all participants. The line up will be from big to small. The line up for the first race (Minis) will take place immediately after the last rider of the trial lap has crossed the finish line. The following races will then be announced. All participants must listen to the announcer! The next age group to start will be called and must be at the start in time. If there aren't enough participants for one or more age groups, two or more age groups will be combined into one race (with separate results, of course!). All cyclists should therefore be within range to hear the announcer.

3. START

The Junior Trophy takes place on Sunday the 25th of May 2025.

The **first** start is at ca. 10:00 am (**Minis**), all other races of age-groups 2022 - 2017 follow with short breaks. The starts of age groups 2016 - 2011 are around 11:30 am.

Whoever is too late for the start or wears no helmet will not be allowed to start.

4. DISTANCES

The separate race classes each contest a round race.

5. AWARD CEREMONY

The award ceremony takes place on the BIKE stage on Sunday the 25th of May 2025 after the last race of the Junior Trophy (ca. 02:00pm). We **kindly** ask all the first to third place winners of the individual categories to be present. In case of not appearing and not having informed us about this absence beforehand, we will raffle the prizes.

6. PRIZES

For the first three places of each category there will be trophies and great material prizes. Each participant will receive a finisher medal at the finishing line. After the award ceremony there will be a raffle of additional material prizes among all the participants.
