


How to keep receiving notifications on iOS 15

When Focus Mode and Scheduled Summary is turned on

Focus Mode

With iOS 15 and iPadOS 15, Focus lets you stay in the moment when you need to concentrate or step away from your device. You can customize Focus settings and choose when you want to receive alerts and notifications, while letting other people and apps know when you're busy.



1. Go to **Settings** > **Focus**



2. Choose the focus mode you're using





Have this Focus turn on automatically at a set time, location, or while using a certain app.


3. Tap on Apps in the Allowed Notification section



4. Tap on add App to select Apps you want to allow when Focus Mode is turned on



5. Choose the apps you want to bypass on Focus Mode and tap Done after you finished.




6. Once you finished, you can see the apps you chose on the Allowed App Section.



Notification Summary

In iOS 15 and iPad 15, a new feature in notification has launched where now user can schedule times to receive a summary of notifications each day at the time determined by the user. The summary is personalized to the users and ordered by priority based on how the user uses the apps, with the most relevant notifications at the top.




1. Go to **Settings** > **Notifications**



2. If you had your Notification Summary turned on, you can see the list of your apps in the notification style section.

3. Choose the app you wanted to make changes



4. Choose **Immediate Delivery** to avoid delay on notification delivery.
