Small Group Discussion Guide For Generous Mindset

Opening Question:

• What are some things people commonly look to for life, joy, peace, and security? How have you personally sought life in these things?

Read: Luke 12:13-21

- 1. Why do you think the man in the crowd wanted Jesus to settle his inheritance dispute?
- 2. What does Jesus' warning in verse 15 teach us about the nature of greed?
- 3. In what ways can an abundance of possessions cause stress and anxiety?
- 4. Looking at the parable, what was wrong with the rich man's approach to wealth?
- 5. What do you think it means to be "rich toward God" (v. 21)? How does that contrast with storing up for ourselves?

Read: Luke 12:22-34

- 1. Jesus tells us not to worry about our life. How is worry connected to what we are seeking?
- 2. What does the example of ravens and wildflowers teach us about God's provision?
- 3. Jesus says that "the pagan world runs after all such things." What does that mean for us as followers of Christ?
- 4. In verse 31, Jesus instructs us to seek His kingdom first. What does that look like practically in daily life?
- 5. Verse 34 says, "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." How can we evaluate where our treasure truly is?

Greed Mindset vs. Generous Mindset

- 1. Review the characteristics of the greed mindset. Have you seen any of these traits in vourself?
- 2. How does fear play a role in a greed mindset?
- 3. Look at the characteristics of a generous mindset. Which of these do you feel strong in? Which do you need to grow in?
- 4. Read 2 Corinthians 9:7. How does this verse challenge your perspective on giving and generosity?
- 5. How can seeking first the kingdom of God add gratitude, contentment, peace, and joy to our lives?

Application & Prayer

- Where is your heart in relation to this teaching? Are there areas where you need to repent and rethink?
- Identify one practical step you can take this week to shift from a greed mindset to a generous mindset.
- Pray together, asking God to help you trust in His provision, seek His kingdom first, and develop a heart of generosity.
