Care & Maintenance Guide

Each biiit piece is handcrafted from natural materials — Hanji (Korean mulberry paper), matte brass, and in some pieces, acrylic. These notes will help the piece age gracefully and keep its intended character over time.

MATERIALS IN THIS COLLECTION

- Hanji (Korean traditional mulberry paper) shades — all models
- Matte brass frame — biiit 001, 002, 003, 004, 005, 010, 011
- Acrylic structural elements — biiit 006, 007

CARING FOR THE HANJI SHADE

- Keep dry at all times — avoid direct water contact and damp cloths.
- Dust gently with a soft, dry brush or a dry microfiber cloth.
- Avoid prolonged direct sunlight; natural fibers may soften in tone over time.
- Small texture variations, fiber marks, and gentle irregularities are part of the handmade nature of hanji — they are a mark of the making process, not a defect.

CARING FOR THE BRASS FRAME

- The brass is left in its natural matte finish and will develop a soft patina over time — this is an intended characteristic of the material, not a flaw.
- Wipe with a dry or barely damp soft cloth only when needed.
- Avoid brass polish, abrasive cleaners, or alcohol-based products, which will strip the intended patina.

ELECTRICAL & GENERAL SAFETY

- Use only the bulb type and maximum wattage specified for your model — see the biiit Technical Data Sheet.
- Do not exceed the recommended wattage; excess heat can damage the hanji shade.
- Always switch off and unplug before cleaning or relocating the piece.
- Keep away from open flame and sustained direct water exposure.

STORAGE & HANDLING

- Store upright in original packaging when not in use.
- Always lift and carry by the frame or base — never by the paper shade.
