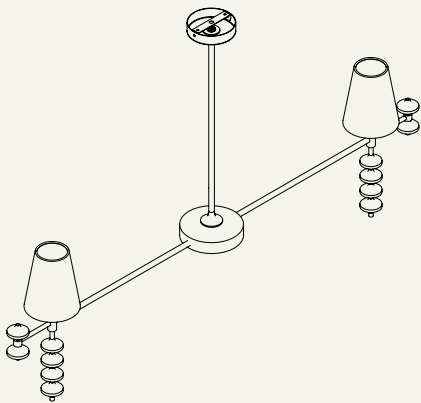
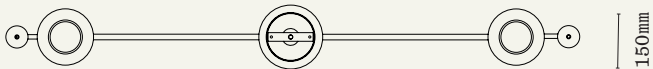


HOUR OLIUS PENDANT 02



Pseudopanax crassifolius - the Latin botanical term for lancewood, or horoeka as it's known in Maori, were the inspiration for the finely formed Olius pendants. The unusual native tree stands out in the New Zealand forest canopy for its spindly shape and teeth-like spine that sprout strange, leathery leaves. One theory is the tough leaves were to deter the hungry and now extinct Moa.

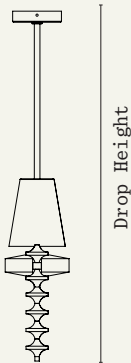
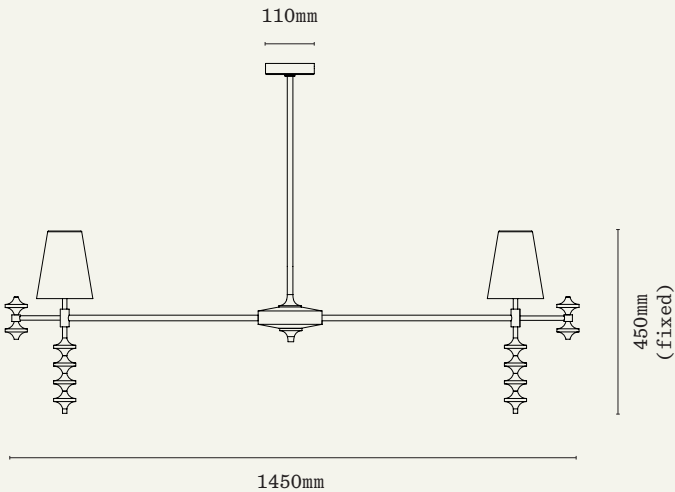
