- Class 1** LEAD REIN DROP POLE Open to all ages and sizes of horse and rider. One round, second half of the course will be timed, against the clock.
- Class 2** **CROSS POLE Competition 35cm** Open to all ages and sizes of horse and rider. One Support person allowed in the ring for just off lead-rein. One round, second half of the course will be timed, against the clock.
- Class 3** **HOBBY HORSE Competition 35cm** Open to all ages and sizes of “horse” and “rider.” One round, second half of the course will be timed, against the clock.
- Class 4** **40cm.** Open to horses or ponies – special rosette to best pony 13.2hh & under. One round, second half of the course will be timed, against the clock.

- Class 5** **50cm.** Open to horses or ponies – special rosette to best pony 14.2hh & under. One round, second half of the course will be timed, against the clock.

GENERAL SHOW CONDITIONS

1. The Judges and Organisers ruling is final
2. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse entries without stating a reason.
3. All jumping competitions will be limited to 25 starters.
4. Any objections must be made to the Secretary in writing and accompanied by a £50 deposit; returnable if objection is sustained.
5. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, spectators, their property, servants or horses in connection with, or arising out of this show.
6. Dogs to be kept on a lead at all times.
7. **Hard hats to standard PAS 015 or EN 1384 must be worn when riding AT ALL TIMES.**
8. All competitors are expected to comply with the Health & Safety requirements whilst on the showground.
9. Where applicable age of child to apply at date of show.
10. Horses/ponies to be minimum 4 years old for all ridden classes.
11. No one shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
12. **Advice from our Insurers:** The onus is on every rider who suffers a fall or anybody who suffers an injury whilst on the showground to report the injury to the Show Secretary.
13. **All horses and ponies entering the meadow must have current Equine Influenza vaccination.**
14. **A £2 per rider fee is asked for to go to non-profit Gryphon First Aid Unit**
