English	<p>We continue to explore our new book, 'How to wash a Woolly Mammoth' by Michelle Robinson. Next week we will identify the structure of the text, create a shared class plan and then begin to create our own plans.</p> <p>In phonics and reading we will continue in our Read Write Inc (RWI) and Accelerated Reader (AR) groups.</p>
Maths	<p>In Maths we continue with addition and subtraction. We will be practicing number bonds to 100, adding and subtracting ones, adding by making 10 and adding three 1-digit numbers next week.</p>
Science	<p>In Science we finish our materials topic. We will be 'working scientifically' to work out the best material for an umbrella.</p>
Foundation subjects	<p>In Art, we are recreating an image of the Eiffel Tower in the pointillist style. Geography looks at the continent of Antarctica and in PSHE we will discuss what we are grateful for. Indoor PE is working with music to create movements that show rhythm and control. We are listening to Hloklaza by Arthur Mofokate in music, as well as singing some harvest songs.</p>
