English	<p>We are finishing our writing sequence using the book, 'How to wash a Woolly Mammoth' by Michelle Robinson and starting to look at our new book, 'Traction Man is here' by Mini Grey.</p> <p>In phonics and reading we will continue in our Read Write Inc (RWI) and Accelerated Reader (AR) groups.</p>
Maths	<p>In Maths we continue with addition and subtraction. We will be subtracting across 10, subtracting from 10, subtracting a 1-digit number from a 2-digit number and looking at 10 more and 10 less next week.</p>
Science	<p>In Science we continue with our topic 'Animals, including humans'. This week we be looking at what makes a healthy diet.</p>
Foundation subjects	<p>In Art, we are finishing our paintings and comparing our creations. Indoor PE moves onto a circuits, outdoor PE focuses on combining movements. We continue with our Christmas performance songs in music and computing looks at logging on and off the Chromebooks. In Geography we are comparing the physical features of Alaska to Cornwall and in RE we are giving a simple account of Jesus' birth. PSHE looks at stereotypes.</p>
