English	<p>We will be reading our new book, 'Traction Man is here' by Mini Grey, role playing conversations between the characters in the book and creating a story map. We will also look at what makes a sentence, focusing on the use of verbs.</p> <p>We have finished assessing all the children (hurrah!), so will start in our new Read Write Inc (RWI) and Accelerated Reader (AR) groups.</p>
Maths	<p>In Maths we continue with addition and subtraction. We are adding and subtracting 10s and adding two 2-digit numbers next week.</p>
Science	<p>In Science we continue with our topic 'Animals, including humans'. Next week we be looking at The Eat Well Guide.</p>
Foundation subjects	<p>We start a design and technology project next week – moving vehicles. We explore axels and axel holders. Indoor PE is circuit training, outdoor PE focuses on aiming balls. We continue with our Christmas performance songs in music and computing looks at logging on and off the Chromebooks. In Geography we are comparing the human features of Alaska and Cornwall and in RE we are looking at how Christians are guided by the Christmas story. PSHE looks at stereotypes.</p>
