

**SSR-408-40/47/54****SumoSprings®****INSTALLATION**

**1.** Park the vehicle on a hard, level surface and engage the emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind the front wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.

**2.** Raise the rear of the vehicle to allow the axle to hang freely and support the frame using safety jack stands. Removal of the rear wheels is optional.

**NOTE:** during installation, refer to the diagram on page 1.

**3.** Starting on the driver side, remove the existing factory bump stop from the retaining cup. While holding it firmly, twist and pull until the bump stop pops out of the retaining cup. It can also be pried out of the retaining cup with a large flat blade screwdriver or something similar.

**4.** Attach the Polyurethane Sumo Top [ITEM B] to the top of one of the SumoSprings [ITEM A] using a M8-1.25 x 50mm Bolt [ITEM C] and a Washer [ITEM D], torque assembly to 2.26Nm or 20lb-in. Be sure to add a drop of blue thread locker to the threads of the bolt [ITEM C] before assembly.

**5.** Place the Polyurethane Sumo Top [ITEM B] portion of the assembly into the retainer cup. Ensure the SumoSpring is firmly in place by pushing and twisting until the SumoSpring is held into place by the internal tangs.

**6.** Repeat steps 3 through 5 on the passenger side of the vehicle.

**7.** Raise the vehicle to allow room to remove the safety jack stands.

**8.** Carefully lower the vehicle and remove the chocks from the wheels.

**9.** Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found attached to the sticker pack in the box your parts came in.
