

INSTALLATION

- 1. Park the vehicle on a hard, level surface and engage the emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.
- 2. Raise the rear of the vehicle allowing the axle to hang free and rest the frame on the safety jack stands rated for the weight of the vehicle. Removal of the rear wheels is optional.
- 3. Starting on the driver side, un-bolt and remove the existing factory bump stop from the underside of the frame and set aside. Keep the factory bolts for attaching the SumoSpring.
- 4. Remove SumoSprings parts from the box. Using the 3/8-16 x 3" FHCS [ITEM D], thread the bolt through the Mounting Bracket [ITEM B] and the 2" Spacer [ITEM C] and attach to the top of the SumoSpring [ITEM A]. Prior to attachment place a drop of Blue Thread Locker on the threaded portion of the 3/8-16 x 3" FHCS and secure tightly.
- **5.** Attach the assembly to the underside of the frame, utilizing the same holes in the underside of the frame from which the factory bump stop was removed, using the same two factory bolts that attached the factory bump stop to the frame.
- **6.** Repeat steps 3 through 5 on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- 7. If rear wheels were removed you can now reinstall the rear wheels and torque wheel nuts to manufacturers specifications.
- **8.** Jack up vehicle, remove safety jack stands.
- **9.** Remove wheel chocks from the front wheels.
- 10. Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
