

#### **INSTALLATION**

- **1.** Park the vehicle on a hard, level surface and engage the emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.
- **2.** Raise the rear of the Jeep, allowing the axle to hang freely. Support the frame using safety jack stands. Removal of the rear wheels is optional.
- **3.** Starting on the driver side, using a socket wrench, unbolt and remove the factory bump stop from the underside of the frame and set aside. Keep the factory bolts you will use these to attach the SumoSpring.
- **4.** Attach the SumoSprings [ITEM A] and the 1" Spacer [ITEM C] to the mounting bracket [ITEM B] using the M8 x 50mm FHCS [ITEM D].

**NOTE:** Before you attach the SumoSprings and bracket to the frame, add a drop of Blue Thread Locker onto the threaded portion of the screw and secure tightly.

- **5.** Use the holes in the frame from which the factory bump stop was removed and attach the SumoSprings assembly to the underside of the frame using the factory bump stop bolts you saved.
- **6.** Repeat steps 3 through 5 on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- **7.** Raise the vehicle to allow room to remove the safety jack stands. If rear wheels were removed you can now reinstall the rear wheels and torque wheel nuts to manufacturers specifications.
- **8.** Carefully lower vehicle to the hard surface and remove the chocks from the wheels.
- **9.** Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
