





### **INSTALLATION**

- **1.** Park the vehicle on a hard, level surface and engage the emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.
- **2.** Raise rear of vehicle allowing the axle to hang freely. Support the frame using safety jack stands.
- **3.** Starting on the driver side, remove the factory bump stop by pulling/prying down the rear and sliding it backward out of the slot in the frame.
- **4.** Apply a drop of Blue Thread Locker to the threads of the stud on the SumoSpring [ITEM A] and thread the Nut Plate [ITEM B] a few threads onto the stud. Ensure that the nut on the Nut Plate is facing up.
- **5.** Insert the Nut Plate [ITEM B] into the slot on the frame from the rear with the notched edge entering the slot first. Ensure that the square part of the Nut Plate is located in the slot and center the SumoSpring over the axle, tighten securely by hand. See diagrams below for details
- **6.** Repeat steps 3 through 5 on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- **7.** Raise the vehicle, remove safety jack stands, and carefully lower vehicle to the hard surface. Remove the chocks in front and back of the rear wheels.
- **8.** Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
