

INSTALLATION

- **1.** Park vehicle of level hard surface. Engage emergency brake. Place ckocks in front and behind the rear wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.
- **2.** Raise front of vehicle allowing the axle to hang freely. Support the frame using safety jack stands.
- **3.** Starting on the driver side, remove existing factory bump stop assembly from the frame.
- **4.** Insert the stud on the end of the SumoSpring [ITEM A] into the hole in the frame where the factory bump stop was located. Install the M8 Flat Washer [ITEM B] and M8 Nyloc Nut [ITEM C] on top of the stud and tighten securely.
- **5.** Repeat steps 3 through 4 on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- **6.** Jack up vehicle, remove safety jack stands.
- **7.** Carefully lower vehicle to the hard surface. Remove the chocks in front and back of the rear wheels.
- **8.** Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
