### ELIGIBILITY

#### **Who is eligible to submit?**

You must be 18 years or older and a resident of the United States.

### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

#### **When is the contest submission deadline?**

The deadline is February 3, 2020 at 11:59 PM EST.

**What is the maximum length of short film that will be accepted?** Projects must not exceed a total viewing time of 3 minutes, including credits

#### **What submission format should I use?**

The following formats will be accepted: .MP4, .AVI, .3GP, .WEBM, .MOV., WMV., .M4V, .MPG, .MKV & .FLV

### PRIZING

#### **What prizes are being offered?**

##### *Finalists*

Up to 3 finalists will be flown to Sun Valley, Idaho in March 2020 for a special screening event at the the Sun Valley Film Festival. Covered expenses for finalist and (1) travel companion include:

- Passes to attend the Sun Valley Film Festival
- Round-trip airfare to Sun Valley, Idaho
- 2 nights/3 days hotel accommodations
- Ground transportation from airport in Sun Valley to hotel and vice versa

##### *Grand Prize*

The winner, selected by a panel of experts after the screenings at the Sun Valley Film Festival, will receive an all-expenses paid National Geographic expedition. The location of the expedition will be announced at a later date.

### **Can you provide feedback on my film?**

Due to the high number of submissions, unfortunately we cannot provide feedback.

### **May I submit my project as a “rough cut?”**

No – all submissions must be completed films.

### **Trademarked Logos or Copyrighted Material in Films**

Filmmakers should avoid any trademarked names or logos appearing in their project. Also, you must have the expressed consent of any individual appearing within your video.
