Chaesung Chun is a professor of political science and international relations at Seoul National University (SNU) and president of the East Asia Institute (EAI).

His previous leadership roles include president of the Korean Association of International Studies (2021), director of the Center for International Studies at SNU, and vice president of the Institute of Peace and Unification Studies at SNU. He has held visiting professorships at Keio University in Tokyo (2017-2018 and 2010-2011) and currently serves on the advisory committees of the Ministry of Unification, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Defense, and the ROK Army and Navy. His major monographs include *The Future World Political Order and A Theory of Topos* (2025), *Sovereignty and International Relations: Northeast Asian International Relations Theory — Politics among Incomplete Sovereign States* (2020), *Sovereignty and International Relations: Modern Sovereign States System and the Evolution of the Empire* (2019), *Is Politics Moral: Reinhold Niebuhr's Transcendental Realism* (2012), and *East Asian International Relations* (2011). Chun received his BA and MA from Seoul National University and his PhD in international relations theory from Northwestern University.
