Trash & Recycling in the Historic District

Republic Services holds the contract for trash removal within the Main Street Business Improvement District. Every business license holder in the district is required to have an account with Republic Services (regardless if you are a member of the HPCA) for one of the services outlined below. • Shared Containers: Please note square footage of business per business license: ______ Many businesses utilize the common containers in Swede Alley for their trash and recycling instead of housing a trash container at their business. This program splits the cost of removal and recycling among those using the program based on square footage and a use factor. This is the most cost-effective option.

Shared container locations:

There are Five (5) containers in Swede Alley that are part of the shared program. Three mixed-use containers: (1) in Swede Alley behind Firewood Restaurant and (2) in the Brew Pub Parking Lot.

• Individual Dumpster

There are some buildings that provide a specific dumpster for tenants to use. Building owner pays the cost for trash removal and depending on the lease, passes on the cost to tenants. Businesses that wish to have an individual dumpster needs to have private property for its location.

Toters

Similar to home trash pick-up, businesses can determine the number of toters they need and can set up a frequency for pick-up. The individual business is responsible for trash removal costs. All toters must be stored inside or screened from view.
