

The Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux is the stepping stone for drivers taking their first steps on the Porsche Motorsport Pyramid. In 2026, the championship will adopt a new format that allows drivers to share a car and its associated costs, making it the perfect way to get started in racing or for fast entrepreneurs with a passion for the sport to continue their hobby.

### RACING FORMAT.

The racing format is based on **one-day events** held during the week, leaving weekends free and minimising missed work or school days during the week.

An additional **pre-event testday** is added to increase driving time, this testday is optional.

Drivers must have a **national racing license** to participate in the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux.

In 2026 it is possible to participate with **1 or 2 drivers** sharing the car this gives the opportunity to also share the cost of the car.

Teams operate from the pit garages.

### RACE DAY FORMAT.

Qualifying	15' - 5' - 15'
Race 1	25'
Race 2	25'
Race 3	45' with mandatory pitstop

### CATEGORIES.

There will be two categories where drivers can participate in:

The **GT3 Cup category** is open to:

- Porsche 911 GT3 Cup (Type 992.1)
- Porsche 911 GT3 Cup (Type 991)

The **GT4 category** is open to:

- Porsche 718 Cayman GT4 RS Clubsport
- Porsche 718 Cayman Clubsport
- Porsche Cayman GT4 Clubsport (type 981)

### TYRE REGULATIONS.

2 sets of Michelin slick tyres are permitted on race day.

### EARLY BIRDS.

Full Season drivers registering before February 15th will receive one complimentary set of tyres with their registration.

### CALENDAR 2026.

In 2026, between May and October, the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux will feature **five rounds** at four renowned circuits in the Benelux region, supporting various motorsport events, from Porsche NL Track Day to the Spa Six Hours.
