Thesis Summary	ANALYSIS Ageing Society is a world trend that strongly characterizes the 21st century. In the 2050 one person on three will be over 65 years old. According to the Active Ageing 's principles an elderly shouldn't be considered as somebody to attend, but an individual that aims for his/her well-being, to have complete autonomy in the everyday life and a participatory social life. An active lifestyle is not only a therapy but also a prevention for the inevitable physical, psychological and cognitive decline due to the age. Activity is what propose new goals, new actions that fill our life and will benefits both for mind and body. Activity as physical exercise helps to keep strength, flexibility and energy level, keeping their own self-sufficiency and improving life quality. Moreover outdoor physical exercise increases benefits and has a strong social value.
	CONCEPT Based on the treated analysis, I develop a service to promote a successful ageing through an innovative system of doing outdoor fitness. It is a fitness circuit that offers a batch of movements and exercises conceived on the main senior's need: keep on having a self-sufficiency daily life with efficient psyco-physical performances. This service hasn't only a preventive but also a therapeutic action by offering to the user a real improvement on the execution of daily tasks and a superior awareness on correct movements.
	DESIGN The system includes four areas which three of them are related to a set of movements of the three parts of the human body (upper body, core body, lower body) and one is related to the balance: they all works on flexibility, strength and coordination. Each area consists in a tubular structure that, thanks to a particular shape and its elements which work as constraints or invitations to the movements, reduces any possibility of mistake or unsuitable positions.
	Furthermore by using different expertise levels the system is suitable both for a more fitter user and a beginner.
