

Furniture Care & Cleaning

Thank you for your investment in fine furniture from Kimball Hospitality. With proper care, this furniture will provide a long, satisfying service life. By following the guidelines below, you will ensure that the beauty and operation of your furniture will last for years

Proper Care Practices

- Dust all surfaces frequently with a clean, damp soft cloth, moving the cloth with the grain.
- Immediately remove any liquids that come in contact with the wood surfaces with a blotting action.
- Lift objects to move them, never pull them across a finished surface.
- Avoid exposure of furniture to extreme heat or cold or to wide variances in humidity.
- Avoid exposure of furniture to strong sunlight, as the wood beneath the finish could change color after prolonged exposure to strong sunlight.
- Protect furniture from exposure to solvents such as nail polish remover, acetate, etc. these solvents can damage the finish.

Polishing

Wood Tops

- Select a no-wax, liquid polish intended for wood furniture.
- Apply a small amount to a clean, soft cloth.
- Wipe the furniture lightly, moving the cloth in the direction of the grain.
- Allow to dry, according to the directions on the polish container.
- Buff with a soft, lint-free cloth using steady, even pressure, wiping with the grain.

High Pressure Laminate (HPL) Tops

- Clean with a mild soap solution.
- Wipe the surface, moving with the grain.
- Dry with a clean, soft cloth.

Granite Cleaning & Care

- Clean stone surfaces with a few drops of non-acidic soap scum remover or a mild liquid dishwashing detergent.
- Frequent or over-use of soap scum remover could result in dulling the surface of the stone.
- Thoroughly rinse and dry the surface after washing.
- Too much cleaner or soap may leave a film and cause streaks.
- Blot spill immediately with a soft cloth.
- Do not use products that contain lemon, vinegar, or other acid content may etch the surface.
- Do not use abrasive cleaner such as dry cleaners or soft cleaners.
- Do not use cleaners that contain acids such as bathroom cleaners, grout cleaners, or tile cleaners..
- Do not mix bleach and ammonia, this combination creates a toxic and lethal gas.

Spills & Stains

- Blot the spill with a paper towel immediately. Do not wipe the area, this will spread the spill.
- Flush the area with plain water and mild soap and rinse several times.
- Dry the area thoroughly with a soft cloth. Repeat as necessary.
