POWER TOOL RECALL

“Do you own a Craftsman Radial Arm Saw?”

Marshall Nathanson called our attention to this recall announced on “The Web: If so, you need to look at the Radial Arm Saw Factory Recall Page. Emerson Tool Company is handling the recall for Sears and is providing a repair kit for a new blade guard or \$100.00 to owners of certain Craftsman 8", 8¼", 9", and 10" Radial Arm Saws. Sears sold the 8", 9", and 10" saws from 1958 through 1992. The 8¼" saws were sold from 1990 through 1995.

Makita, Porter Cable and Milwaukee Tools

Woodshop News announced that Makita, Porter Cable and Milwaukee are recalling about 180,000 power tools that use certain switches made by Eaton Corp because the switches “stick” and the tool can continue to run even though the switch appears “off.” The tools which were sold from January to September 2000 are”

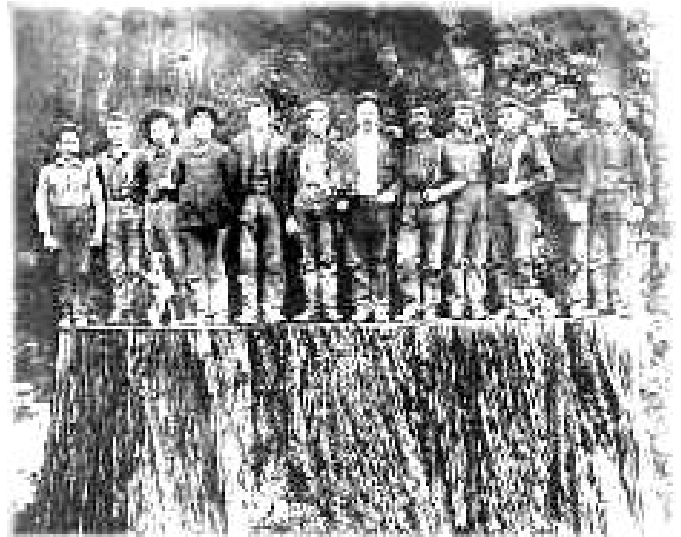
