Owner must vacate & dispose of goods ASAP.

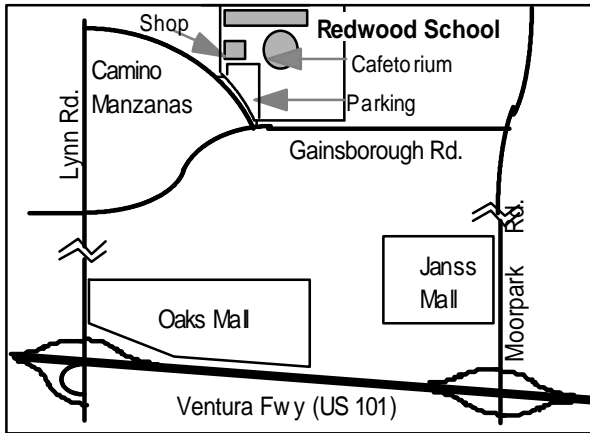

All features work. The tilt control binds and needs disassembly, cleaning and/or adjustment. It is usable as is for vertical blade cuts. The saw comes with (2) table extensions, taper jig, (2) metal spring hold-downs, universal jig, miter gage and fence. \$100 OBO.
