Arlen Handberg demonstrates many jigs and accessories for the router and router table.



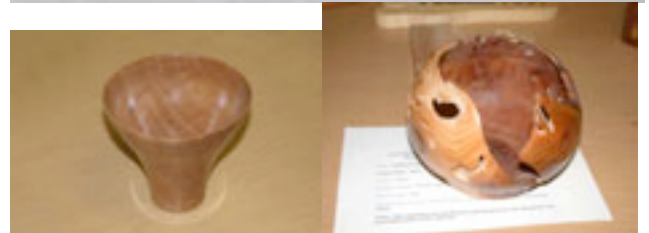

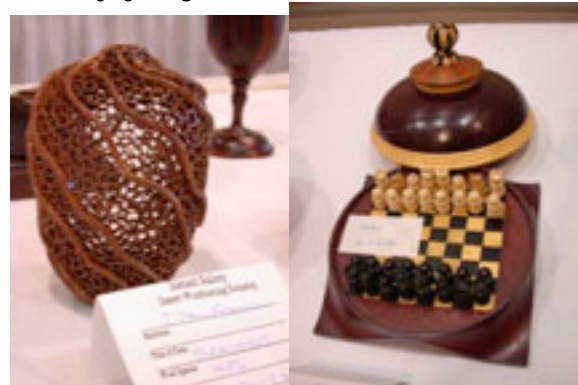
