While you are thinking of that old tool that you rarely use anymore, think also about making something to donate. We're a bunch of skilled woodworkers, and we really appreciate the skills of other members. Those items have a lot more meaning to us than a white elephant tool (although we like those too!), so start planning now to make something to donate for the auction. Several members have already offered to donate items in their specialty.

October 7th is our annual fund-raising auction. It's one of the most fun and widely attended meetings we have, so be sure to arrive early (about 6pm) and check out the lots up close. Because we have always run out of time, and not been able to get some lots to the block, we will be changing the procedures to get more accomplished in one evening. So, as Gunney Sgt. Lee Ermey says, LISTEN UP!! There won't be any discussion or passing around of items once they reach the block. You will need to inspect all items before the auction, and make your own notes of the lot numbers on which you want to bid. Secondly, there will only be two times you can check out and pay for your purchases: For those who wish to leave early, there will be an intermission mid-way through the auction, when you can pay and check out. Once checked out, you can no longer bid on further items. You could, however, have a friend who's staying bid for you, but he'll have to pay for and check the item out. Work that out with a friend if you leave

early. The only other time to check out will be after auctions close. We are also planning to move the viewing tables away from the door and the checkout area near the door to facilitate an easier checkout. Payment for your items must be by cash or check only. Be sure to have larger items at the school by 6pm, and all items by 6:30. Also, some of the best selling items are those made by fellow members, so you're encouraged to bring something you made too.
