Make anything out of wood.

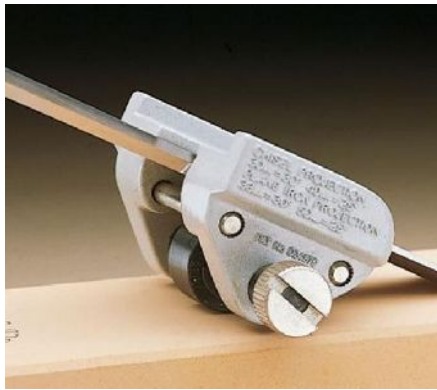
